HURRICANE SEASON 2022

I urricane season starts June 1 and runs through November 30th.

Now is the time to plan what you will do if a Hurricane is forecast to hit the Tampa Bay area. If an evacuation order is issued, Palm Hill is a mandatory evacuation zone as are all mobile home communities. Should you choose to remain in the park and need medical or emergency assistance, the authorities will not respond as they will be dealing with other emergencies, and you should have heeded the evacuation order.

The nearest shelter is Largo High School 410 Missouri N. Largo; this is a pet friendly shelter but will fill up quickly. The 2 Clubhouses here in Palm Hil*l are not* rated as hurricane shelters and therefore cannot be used by residents as a shelter. Due to Liability issues both clubhouses will be locked down when an evacuation order is issued.

Ensure that your gutters are cleaned out and any pots, chairs, planters, or anything that may become airborne are stored either in the shed or inside the mobile. Maintenance is responsible for ensuring that the common areas are secured.



Residential Security Check: How secure is your home? The residential security assessment is a free home security consultation with Largo Police Officers that are certified as Residential Home Security and Crime Prevention experts.

Operation Serial Number: Recording serial numbers of all items in your home is a critical crime prevention step.

Bring Loved Ones Home Safely with SafetyNet: A tracking system with an RMS ID Bracelet to help bring loved ones home safely.

The Yellow Dot & Vial Of Life Program: It helps people communicate about medical conditions when one can't speak for themselves.

THIS MONTH IN HISTORY

June 3, 1937 - The Duke of Windsor married Wallis Warfield Simpson in Monts, France. As King Edward VIII, he had abdicated the British throne in December of 1936 amid tremendous controversy to marry Simpson, an American who had been divorced. Following the wedding, the couple lived in France and had minimal contact with the British Royal family. The Duke died in Paris on May 28, 1972, and was buried near Windsor Castle in England.

Birthday - June 1, 1926 - Marilyn Monroe (1926-1962) was born in Los Angeles (as Norma Jean Mortensen). Following an unstable childhood spent in foster homes and orphanages, she landed a job as a photographer's model which led to a movie career. She later married baseball legend Joe DiMaggio. Beneath her glamorous movie star looks she was fragile and insecure and eventually succumbed lune to the pressures of Hollywood life. 



The reopening of the pro shop continues to be the focus of the Committee's work.
We are developing budget considerations, determining, and recommending hours of operation based on the season, and at the present time providing oversight consultation to our Palm Hill management.

After 50 years of known quality and quantity in pro shop management, our biggest challenge appears to be change and developing new routines.

Our new pro shop manager is proactive in providing services to our golfers and to Palm Hill management. The hours for May were cut to ten or less per week so that greens fees, score cards and cash envelopes and other daily consumables like sign in sheets can be replenished without having to take the time from our management team in the office.

Our goal is to turn oversight of the pro shop over to our management team and the Golf Committee to only get involved on an as needed basis.

The bench project continues to progress. Twenty-four benches have been donated by residents, about half have been placed and the plaques for the dedications have all been ordered. Mary Leslie has done an excellent job in overseeing this undertaking. Hopefully, this project will be finished in the next 60 days.






