

For those of you that are staying in Doral for the summer. REMEMBER; you are now in Hurricane Season.

IF AN EVACUATION ORDER IS GIVEN BY PINELLAS COUNTY, ALL MOBILE HOMES MUST EVACUATE!!

NEW 2022 <u>Pinellas County Hurricane Preparedness Guides</u> in English or Spanish are available **NOW** from the Office, the Clubhouse or ask a Board Member how to get one.

Make plans **NOW** for **YOUR** response to an Emergency Evacuation Order from the County. When the Evacuation order is given, you may have no more than a day or perhaps two to prepare; so prepare prior to the Evacuation. Think about the following issues that **YOU** are responsible for.

- **1. WHERE are you going to go?** <u>NO BUILDING in DORAL</u> is rated for shelter. YOU must arrange to stay with relatives or friends or hotels or designated shelters. The main water valve to the Park will be shut off during an Evacuation.
- **2. WHAT do you need to take with you?** Insurance Documents, Ownership Documents, Medications etc.
- **3.** DO you have a Pet or other Animal(s)? Only certain shelters and certain hotels will accept animals depending on their policies and size of the animal.
- 4. HOW are you going to get there? Do you have a car or a friend with a car?
- **5. WHAT** do you need to do to lock up your unit and remove loose items from outside (They could fly away during a hurricane!). Shut off water valve and water heater.
