

Don't wait until our area is threatened by a hurricane to stock up on batteries, water, and other necessities ...everyone else needs the same items...making them scarce at the time.

It is so great to see participation in activities continuing in the summer. Monday Bingo is going strong and don't forget about the weekly Coffee Klatch, Water Aerobics, monthly potluck, ladies' luncheons, and games day. Thanks go out to all who have volunteered to plan and advertise those activities. 

An Interchange is planned midway between SR 580 and SR 586 (Curlew Road), just north of Boy Scout Rd. This interchange will accommodate U-turn movements between northbound and southbound frontage roads and serve as a pedestrian crossing. In addition to the interchange, pedestrians will have a dedicated underpass between Evans Rd. and Republic Dr.

A new interchange at SR 586 (Curlew Road) will also be added so that US 19 traffic will travel uninterrupted as it passes over SR 586. New ramps will provide access to new frontage roads and SR 586.

A new pedestrian bridge over US 19 is planned at Northside Dr. Right of way will be acquired for storm water ponds.

The project is currently in design. Construction is anticipated to begin in early 2023

Project 256774-2 has been combined with this one for a single construction project. All updates will be posted on this page.



This Month meet Frances Unterborg / Frannie / Fran



During the Civil War there was a factory that made uniforms for the union soldiers that was built next to a dam on the Wappingers Creak. The houses built in the neighborhood were for factory workers and the people who ran the factory. This was also part of the underground railroad. Fran's house was one that had a secret room behind the fireplace.

There was a hill on the road that ran past where the factory had been built. Fran and all the neighborhood friends would all go sledding in the winter on the "dam" hill as they called it. Also, there was a big swamp they would go ice-skating on. Fran's father, Harold Misner, was on the Town of Poughkeepsie Recreation Committee and he was instrumental in having the swamp made into one large pond. Tall spotlights were installed so there could be night ice-skating. Also, he was instrumental in having a park built down by the

When Fran was a Junior in high school, her family moved further out in the country on top of a mountain on fourteen acres. Here she was able to have a horse. She also helped working on the farm her new friends lived on and loving it.

After graduating high school, Fran went to business school. After graduating she became a personal assistant in an insurance agency until the children came along.

Fran met her husband, Walt, who was a friend of her brothers. They had two children, Tammy and Karl. Fran became a 4-H leader of two clubs, a General Club, cooking, sewing etc. and a Dairy Goat Club. The family raised dairy goats and the children showed them in New York and Connecticut. She was a leader for seventeen years. Fran loved working with kids.

When her son was in eighth grade, he went from public school to a Christian school. Fran started working at the school as a teacher assistant. She worked there for eight years. Then she worked for friends who owned two Hallmark gift stores. She worked there for eight years. When her husband of forty-two years passed away, she retired. She sold her home and moved down to Riviera to live and take care of her mother Dorothy Misner. Her parents had purchased their home in Riviera in 1973. 

Snickerdoodle Muffins

Yields 12-14 standard muffins Ingredients:

- 1 cup unsalted butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 eggs
- 3/4 teaspoon baking soda

Oven temp: 350F

- 3/4 teaspoon baking powder
- 3/4 teaspoon cream of tartar
- 3/4 teaspoon nutmeg
- 1 1/4 cups sour cream
- 2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour



for topping:

- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 Tablespoon cinnamon

Directions:

- 1. Cream room temp butter and sugar until soft about 3-5 minutes. Add vanilla, then add eggs one at a time and mix until each is incorporated.
- 2. In a separate bowl, sift together the flour, baking soda, baking powder. cream of tartar and nutmeg.
- 3. Fold in with a spatula the flour mixture and the sour cream alternately to the egg/butter mixture. Start and end with the flour being careful not to over mix.
- 4. Using an ice cream scoop, scoop out muffin batter, one at a time and drop into a shallow bowl filled with the sugar, cinnamon mixture. Roll to cover completely. Place covered muffin batter into prepared muffin tin.
- 5. Bake for approximately 20-22 minutes and golden brown. Let cool in pan about 3-5 minutes before removing to a cooling rack. Enjoy!!


