





The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed, and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone. Use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and wellbeing of everyone, please do not go in the hot tub or pool if you are not feeling well, have wounds or open sores.

dditional guests staying overnight in the park must be registered and paid for. Cost is \$9 per person per night, \$55 per person per week and \$180 per person per month.

Residents must accompany their guests while at the pool or other locations and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct.


e have received many complaints about people not cleaning up after their animals and not walking them in the pet area. Pet areas are marked on the map.




