HURRICANE SEASON 2022

re did not need to shovel snow again this winter! OK, some fauna suffered from frost - but that grew back. Have you noticed that one of our two seasons, 'wet' is almost the same as hurricane season? True. As usual, June 1 – Nov 30 is when Floridians need to prepare. You can check with various sources regarding the predications for the season. www.npr.org www.reuters.com www.cnn.com www.accuweather.com www.nhc.noaa.gov

All of the experts agree upon a few things:

Prepare an evacuation plan. The county opens shelters in numerous locations. Or you may decide to drive to a distant safe area. Because we live in manufactured homes, we are encouraged to evacuate. If you decide to ride out the storm, you are on your own if emergency services are needed. You may call – but they may not be able to respond.

Have a go-kit ready. Suggestions include spare keys, cash (ATM may not work), two weeks supply of medications, phone chargers, hygiene items, insurance papers/info, batteries and flashlight, radio and rain gear. Any thing else of importance that you do not want to lose.

Check your checklist. Pinellas County, the American Red Cross, Ready.gov are great sources

Special needs? Emergency management provides a special needs registry. Contact them at the beginning of hurricane season at specialneeds.pinellascounty.org or call 727-464-3800 to receive a form in the mail. If you have a service animal, be certain to share that info. Not all of the shelters are prepared to accept animals.

When you shop for groceries, look for the Pinellas County complete hurricane preparedness bulletin, many stores have them available. All of the shelters are listed. Some do take animals. Consider picking up a couple extra non-perishable items, water, hand sanitizer, meal bars, canned meat and vegetables, etc. You may need to bring your own food to a shelter.

Keep in mind that it may take days or weeks to restore power to the area. Consider keeping the gas tank in your car full during hurricane season. If you evacuate the area, always good to start out with a full tank. If you stay, always good to have a full tank incase the pumps run out or have no power.

But be prepared. Just in case.

Emotional Support Animal Reminder

Briar Creek II has a process where emotional support animals are allowed in the non-pet section, <u>only</u> after approval by the Board. The support animal must conform to the same restrictions as the Pet Section of the community.

We will need paperwork from a medical professional that states the following:

- Verifies that you have a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities
- Describes your need for a reasonable accommodation to keep a support animal in your home
- Shows the relationship between your disability and the need for the support animal An Emotional Support Animal certificate does not meet the above requirements.

After the accommodation is approved, the resident must provide a photo of the animal, proof of current immunizations and proper licensing by Pinellas County and again at each renewal/revaccination.

Please remember, the animal should be leashed and under your control at all times and not be allowed on private property of your neighbors. The animal should be walked in the Pet Section of Briar Creek II. Common areas in the non-pet section are not to be used to walk your dogs. Remember to clean up after your pet and dispose of it properly. The animal should not create a nuisance or unreasonably disturb the peaceful enjoyment of the community.

If for some reason, you no longer have your support animal and wish to have another one, you must repeat the approval process from the Condo Board.

Please remember approval for an Emotional Support Animal needs to be completed prior to obtaining your animal.



Bleach Is Poison

In the past few years, the chlorine bleach manufacturers have really been pushing their products as disinfectants. While it's true that chlorine bleach will get rid of bacteria, mold, and viruses on surfaces, the fact is that bleach will kill everything, including you, if it's misused. It's a highly poisonous chemical. It should never be mixed with other cleaning solutions and should always be diluted for use.

Chlorine bleach is also unnecessary. There are many alternatives that clean just fine without the dangers. Here are a few.

- 1. Hot soapy water. Remember this? It's still a great way to clean surfaces such as countertops. Rinse off and allow to air dry thoroughly.
- 2. Vinegar. You can use vinegar diluted in water for cleaning many surfaces (3 parts water to 1 part vinegar at most). I use it on my wood floors. You can also use it to kill weeds along driveway seams without the danger of killing everything around it or ruining the surface.
- 3. Lemon juice. The cleaning action of lemon juice is much like that of vinegar. Also, you can add it to laundry instead of bleach.
- 4. Baking soda. Adding one-half cup to your laundry will boost your detergent's cleaning power.
- 5. Hydrogen peroxide. You may have used this for first aid, and it can also be used, diluted 1:1, for disinfection of surfaces after they have been cleaned. It's non-toxic and odor free.


