



or Kathy and me, travel is one of the great joys of life and we have stayed in a wide variety of accommodations. Over the past several years, we have booked many of our vacation lodgings through private rental apps Airbnb and Vrbo (Vacation Rentals by Owner) rather than through traditional hotels, resorts, or rental agencies. While unfamiliar and perhaps even intimidating to many folks in our age bracket, we have found these apps easy to use and reliable in delivering an enjoyable rental experience. Here's how they work and why we are fans.

Both Airbnb and Vrbo are online services (apps) that connect travelers with privately owned rental accommodations. Lodging options can range from a whole house to a separate apartment to a single bedroom in a home. On our recent meandering drive back from Florida, we stayed in lovely modern apartment buildings in Memphis and Nashville, and an adorable self-contained cottage in Ashville, NC. Using the filters in the apps, it is easy to find the size and type of rental to fit your space requirements and budget. You can also filter on specific amenities or features, such as full kitchen, washer/dryer, wi-fi, and so on. We don't like to share a bathroom or living space with other guests, so we filter out anything that isn't a whole house/apartment.

Through the app, you communicate directly with the owner, not through a rental agent. This makes it easy to ask any specific questions about the property. We have found the owners (or "hosts" in Airbnb lingo) are very responsive and eager to provide whatever information you need and to resolve any issues with the rental, should that occur. For an upcoming trip to Seattle, we asked the host if we could exceed the specified number of guests to host a family gathering for a day, and the owner agreed, so we went ahead with the booking. On Airbnb we usually rent through "superhosts" – a category that denotes a high level of satisfaction among renters (guests). Booking, payment, cancellations, and refunds are all handled through the app. Tip: Always read the reviews from previous guests before deciding to book!

One advantage with these apps is that you can narrow your search to find accommodations in a specific neighborhood where there may not be a hotel. On our recent visit to Memphis, our Airbnb apartment was an equally short walk from the trendy Gulch neighborhood and the Beale Street nightlife. In addition, the app can connect you with Airbnb Experiences – activities designed and led by knowledgeable locals, such as walking tours, bike tours and more. We had an awesome food truck tour in Portland, Oregon last year! We also enjoy the feeling of coming "home" after a busy day of touring or hiking, and having our own kitchen and living space in which to create a simple meal and a relaxing evening.

At the end of your visit, you are asked to rate your stay and your host. There is a public review available to all users, and you also can offer private tips that only the host will see, such as "hey, it would be nice if you had a couple boxes of Kleenex around the apartment." Equally important, the host rates you as a guest, which helps other hosts decide if they want to rent to you. So, it is important for us guests to be on our best behavior too! If you are looking for a different kind of experience the next time you travel, consider giving Airbnb or Vrbo a try. Maybe you'll get hooked like we did!

As it explores sexual desire and identity, ambition, gentrification, education, class and status, and the life-altering facts of parenthood, Red at the Bone most strikingly looks at the ways in which young people must so often make long-lasting decisions about their lives--even before they have begun to figure out who they are and what they want to be.

GROWING UP

grew up in several states and countries being military and never thought I was raised by lower to middle income parents during a time when most everyone treated each other with respect. We didn't eat a lot of fast food because it was considered a treat, not a



food group. We drank Kool-Aid made from water that came from our kitchen sink with real sugar. We ate bologna sandwiches, or even tuna (which was in a can not a pouch), PB&J & grilled cheese sandwiches, hot dogs, but mostly homemade meals consisting of mainly rice, meat, potatoes, vegetables, bread, butter, and homemade dessert. Everything was fried back then too...porkchops, chicken, CFS with some shake and bake chicken and chops every once in a while lol.

We grew up during a time when we mowed lawns, pulled weeds, babysat, delivered newspapers and helped neighbors with chores to be able to earn our own money.

We went outside a lot to play~Kick ball, football, basketball, fish, swim, ride bikes, frisbee, run with friends & played hide and seek. We drank tap water from the water hose outside... bottled water was unheard of. If we had a coke - it was in a glass bottle... and we didn't break the bottle when finished...

We watched TV shows like Good Times, The Jefferson's, Gunsmoke, Scooby Doo, Mork and Mindy, Different Strokes, Full House, Leave It To Beaver, Gilligan's Island, Happy Days, Bewitched, The Brady Bunch, The Rifleman, Looney Tunes, The Flintstones, The Jetsons, Sanford and Son, Dukes of Hazzard, WWF Wrestling, I Dream of Jeannie, The Andy Griffith Show, Little House On The Prairie, Friday Night Videos, and I Love Lucy. After school, we came home and did homework and chores, before going outside or having friends over. We would ride our bikes for hours. We had to tell our parents where we were going, who we were going with, and be home when the street lights came on!

You LEARNED from your parents instead of disrespecting them, and treating them as if



they knew absolutely nothing. What they said was LAW, and you did not question it, and you had better know it!!!

In school we said the Pledge of Allegiance, we stood for the National Anthem, and listened to our teachers.

REMINDER ABOUT INSURANCE: If you have given me an updated copy of your homeowner's insurance lately, thank you. But, if you have not, or you aren't sure if you've lapsed or for those of you who know you are not carrying insurance on your home, this is the time to get that taken care of. I can't stress the importance of how



necessary this is, and, because of that importance, we will be cracking down on anyone who doesn't have an updated policy on file with the office.

Next, and just as important, is *updated contact information for all persons living in the park*. If you have an email address, please give that info to the office and be sure if you've given it before, that it's updated. Don't assume that we have an updated email address because you gave it sometime in the past. I have several people with email addresses on file who, when I've sent out an email blast, they are being returned undeliverable. So, perhaps, at one time you did give the office your email address but since then it's changed. *I also need updated phone numbers and, very important, emergency contact info.* The reason I say updated is because recently, I had to call the emergency contact info on file of a resident however, it was very outdated and the emergency contact person on file was someone who passed away years ago. That will not help in an emergency.

Lastly, if you plan to sell your coach, please let the office know so that we may help you and/or your realtor get it done correctly. SUMMARY OF WESTWIND II ROC BOARD MEETING - MAY, 2022

The Westwind II Resident Owned Community Board of Directors held its monthly meeting on May 10, 2022 with all Board members present.

Invoices were approved to be paid to three vendors for 1.), irrigation repair and revamp work around the clubhouse, 2.), replacement parts and filter for the A/C unit in the clubhouse and 3.), additional pool work required at the time of regular pool service.

In new business the Board approved the following proposals and quotes to:

- Pressure wash and paint the two sheds used at the clubhouse.
- Rebuff and polish the floors of the exercise room, library, hallway, kitchen and main floor of the clubhouse.
- Correct the heat and air conditioning issues between the office and the exercise room.
- Replace the broken treadmill in the exercise room with a new treadmill.
- Upgrade clubhouse electrical panel because of insurance mandate.
- Recover the pool table in the exercise room because of regular wear and tear.

There was discussion regarding the use of purchase orders to help with internal controls. It was agreed this would be discussed at a future Board meeting in order to have the time to further clarify and understand how the procedure might be used.
