



I took pictures of the sunflowers growing in Sandy's front garden, the impatiens growing in the cement wall in front of June's home and the blooming century plant in the side garden at Joe and Liz's home. When Jim and I lived at Bay Pines Mobile Home Park, we had a corner lot with two century plants in our front yard and one in our side yard. The century plant in our side yard grew a mast or stalk that was higher than the electricity or telephone wires going by. It did flower. I'm going to need a telescopic lens to see what happens to Joe and Liz's plant. I never trimmed ours, it was au natural and beautiful.









One plant that you do not want to see in your yard is an invasive vine that is not native to Florida called momordica charantia or balsam apple. Terry and I spotted this vine covering a red hibiscus in Larry and Jennifer's yard. In the morning, we went over with a large black garbage bag and filled that bag with the balsam apple vine that had covered the hibiscus. The seeds in the orange pods get eaten by birds and animals and are then dispersed. We didn't want that to happen.







National Disability Independence Day, July 26. Commemorating the signing of the Americans with Disabilities Act in 1990, assuring Americans with disabilities access to civic and economic opportunities.

Share these facts about the Declaration of Independence

ou know July 4th is for fireworks and parades, but how much do you know about its history? The facts may surprise you. The Automatic Payroll Systems website shares these little-known facts about the nation's founding:

- The Declaration of Independence wasn't signed on July 4. The Second Continental Congress voted on the Declaration on July 2, 1776, and it was finalized on July 4, but it wasn't signed by a majority until Aug. 2. Because of all this, John Adams, the 2nd president of the United States, didn't recognize or celebrate July 4th as Independence Day.
- The vote was not unanimous. Richard Henry Lee proposed a bill declaring independence on June 7, 1776. Twelve of the 13 colonies voted to adopt it; New York abstained. On July 4, only nine of the colonies voted in favor of the declaration; Pennsylvania and South Carolina voted against it, New York abstained again, and Delaware was undecided.
- The declaration had a strategic purpose. The point of the formal declaration was to attract foreign allies in the fight for independence. The signers wanted to present the 13 colonies as a united front, or they felt other countries like France wouldn't take them seriously.

About the signers: Fifty-six people signed the document. Eight were born in Britain; the rest were born colonists (all were still technically British subjects at the time of the signing). One signer recanted after being captured by British forces. The last person to sign was Matthew Thornton, on Nov. 4, 1776.






