



Options for Disposal of Household Items and Furniture

Please consider one of the following organizations for donating items to people less fortunate, rather than just throwing things away. For items that are no longer usable, they may be disposed of in the temporary dumpster on Eagle Drive South adjacent to the golf course. The majority of the organizations (exception of Goodwill, Am Vets, and Pinellas County) will enter your unit to remove items.

The Salvation Army – 1446 South Missouri, Largo, 727-447-1913 – Pickups need to be scheduled. They will take donations of used household items and haul away good used furniture. Closes at 6:00 PM most nights and are closed on Sundays.

AJ's Beds and Furniture – 727-588-0406 – Possibly buy good used furniture.

New to You Thrift Center – 727-465-4261 – They will haul away good used furniture; however, is must be at least four (4) items.

Goodwill – 1460 Missouri Ave N, Largo, 727-581-7069 – They will take donations of good used household items. Closes at 6:00 PM most nights.

Am Vets – 1608 Belcher Rd S, Largo (across from Circle K gas station, next to Pete's Barber Shop) – They will take donations of used household items. Monday – Saturday 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM and Sunday 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

Leonard Britch – 727-667-7301 – He will come into your unit and haul away items and old appliances that are no longer usable for a reasonable fee.

This manual is available from the office or may be downloaded from the FVRA website (Fairway Info; Home Buyers information, ARC revised P and P). Before you begin your project, please obtain a home replacement or Modification Request form from the FVRA office or download it (page 12, Exhibit D, in the manual) and return the completed form to the FVRA office. The ARC, which meets most Mondays in the Clubhouse, looks forward to working with you in replacing your home or planning the changes to the outside of your home.



Share these facts about the Declaration of Independence

ou know July 4th is for fireworks and parades, but how much do you know about its history? The facts may surprise you. The Automatic Payroll Systems website shares these little-known facts about the nation's founding:

- The Declaration of Independence wasn't signed on July 4. The Second Continental Congress voted on the Declaration on July 2, 1776, and it was finalized on July 4, but it wasn't signed by a majority until Aug. 2. Because of all this, John Adams, the 2nd president of the United States, didn't recognize or celebrate July 4th as Independence Day.
- The vote was not unanimous. Richard Henry Lee proposed a bill declaring independence on June 7, 1776. Twelve of the 13 colonies voted to adopt it; New York abstained. On July 4, only nine of the colonies voted in favor of the declaration; Pennsylvania and South Carolina voted against it, New York abstained again, and Delaware was undecided.
- The declaration had a strategic purpose. The point of the formal declaration was to attract foreign allies in the fight for independence. The signers wanted to present the 13 colonies as a united front, or they felt other countries like France wouldn't take them seriously. About the signers: Fifty-six people signed the document. Eight were born in Britain; the

rest were born colonists (all were still technically British subjects at the time of the signing). One signer recanted after being captured by British forces. The last person to sign was Matthew Thornton, on Nov. 4, 1776.




