





earching once again for a great summertime recipe, we found this one from the 2019 Lincolnshire cookbook (still available for sale to new residents – just call me) contributed by former resident Shirley A. Thompson:



BANANA SPLIT CAKE"

5 bananas 2 eggs

1 lg. cool whip 2 c. confectioners' sugar

3 sticks butter (I use butter) 1 lg. can crushed pineapple (drained)

2c. graham cracker crumbs ½ c. maraschino cherries chopped

½ c. chopped nuts

Mix 1 stick of margarine with graham cracker crumbs. Pat into 9 X 13 pan. Beat 2 sticks of margarine, 2 eggs, and 2 cups confectioners' sugar for 15 minutes. Spread over graham cracker crust. Cover with sliced bananas and spread with drained pineapple. Place cool whip on top and sprinkle with mixture of chopped nuts and cherries. Refrigerate for 24 hours. (You can garnish with chocolate syrup be fore serving as well)





- 5. Never leave small children alone with your animals. For safety, let your pets sniff small visitors hands before trying to pet them, handle their toys, of offer them treats. More next month.

any of you have asked how and where you can get a Military ID Card renewed. You can go to any Real Time Automated Personnel Identification System (RAPIDS). These may be called the Pass and ID office, Military Personnel



Flight, DEERS office, Personnel Support Detachment, ID Card Section, S1, One Stop, or a variety of other names, depending on the installation or branch of service. RAPIDS offices are located on military bases, at National Guard armories and at reserve training locations. You must be currently enrolled and have your information up to date in the Defense Eligibility Enrollment Reporting System (DEERS) to renew yours or your spouse's ID card and normally must have your current Military ID and a second form of identification which is required for ID card reissuance. The following is a link for the RAPIDS locations etc. https://idco.dmdc.osd.mil/idco/

Retirees and family members whose cards expired before the end of July faced a deadline of Jan. 31, 2022. The deadlines do not apply to anyone holding an ID card with an indefinite expiration date -- generally retirees and family members aged 65 and older.

To renew your card, go to the BX at MacDill AFB and then go to the Kiosk machine by the Tattoo Shop. Bring with you 2 forms of ID, follow the questions on the screen, scan your documents, take a photo, and hit submit. Your request will be sent to the ID Card office on MacDill AFB for renewal. You will be able to pick up your ID card within 30 calendar days.

There are two ways of obtaining it Through the VA if you are registered there just follow the link or copy it and put it in your Browser https://www.VA GOV, then follow the instructions on the page. Again, you must have an account! Then click on the VA Home.



This will take 2 articles as important. Let's face the issue, our skin does change with age. It can become thinner than and not as smooth as it once did. Our veins and bones can be seen more easily especially on our arms and legs. Scratches, cuts, or bumps can take longer to heal. Add a year or more of being out in the sunlight for a long time may lead to wrinkles, dryness, age spots, and even skin cancer. But there are things we can do now and every day to protect our skin and to make it feel and look better. Our skin, a major organ, is now and has always been a major defense against all sorts of stuff that can really hurt us.

Dry Skin and Itching is certainly number one of our complaints. Where and why? Often on our lower legs, elbows, and lower arms. Dry skin patches feel rough and scaly. Some reasons for dry skin, not drinking enough water, spending too much time in the sun, being in very dry air conditioned air, and even stress. Plus, we lose sweat and oil glands.

Dry skin also can be caused by health problems, such as diabetes or kidney disease. Using too much soap, antiperspirant, or perfume and taking hot baths can make dry skin even worse.

Some medicines can make skin itchy. Because older people have thinner skin, scratching can cause bleeding that may lead to infection. Or just plain ugly looking forearms not caused by blood anticoagulants.

Here are some easy ways to help dry, itchy skin: Use moisturizers, like lotions, creams, or ointments, every day. Take fewer baths or showers and use milder soap. Warm water is less drying than hot water. Don't add bath oil to your water. It can make the tub too slippery. <u>Falls are a common occurrence</u> for us. And try using a humidifier, an appliance that adds moisture to a room especially in our winter months.

Bruising happens more easily than younger people. It can take longer for these bruises to heal. Some medicines or illnesses may also cause bruising. In Florida we often don't wear full cloth coverings. Talk to your doctor if you see bruises and don't know how you got them, especially on parts of your body usually covered by clothing.

Over time, skin begins to wrinkle. Things in the environment, like ultraviolet (UV) light from the sun, can make the skin less elastic. Gravity can cause skin to sag and wrinkle. Geez. Certain habits, like smoking, also can wrinkle the skin. A lot of claims are made about how to make wrinkles go away. Most of them don't seem to work and a big waste of our money. Some methods can be painful or even dangerous, and many must be done by a doctor. I can only hope. Talk with a doctor specially trained in skin problems, called a dermatologist.

Age spots, once called "liver spots," are flat, brown spots often caused by years in the sun. They are bigger than freckles and commonly show up on areas like the face, hands, arms, back, and feet. Using a broad-spectrum <u>sunscreen</u> that helps protect against two types of the sun's rays (UVA and UVB) may prevent more age spots. Of importance is to consider using sunscreen even in our homes as sun **simply gets in!** Many Medicare Advantage plans over the counter benefits have no cost sunscreen. Order it and use it.


