





## **RECIPE for AUGUST**

## Frittata with Italian Sausage & Veggies

#### **Ingredients**

1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil

2 Whole 30-compliant Italian sausage links sliced into ¼ inch thick slices

1 ½ cup bell peppers diced

1/3 cup yellow onion diced

1/3 cup white mushroom sliced

12 large eggs

1/4 cup nutritional yeast

1 teaspoon salt

½ teaspoon ground white pepper

½ teaspoon garlic powder

½ teaspoon onion powder

½ teaspoon red pepper flakes



#### **Directions**

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Prep ingredients. Slice sausage links into ½ inch thick rounds. Dice bell pepper and onion. Thinly slice mushrooms.

Add **extra virgin olive oil** to a large ovenproof skillet (or casserole baking dish) and heat over medium heat until hot but not smoking.

Add the **sliced sausage** and cook until lightly browned and cooked through (about 5 minutes for precooked sausage links and 10 minutes for raw sausage links).

Stir in the **bell peppers, onions** and **mushrooms** and cook until they begin to soften, about 3 minutes. Remove the skillet from the heat once vegetables begin to soften.

While the sausage and vegetables cook, whisk together eggs, nutritional yeast, salt, ground white pepper, garlic powder, onion powder and red pepper flakes.

Pour the egg mixture into the skillet with the sausage and vegetables and stir until well combined.

Bake in preheated oven until the top is lightly browned and the eggs are fluffy and cooked through, about 25 minutes.

Let frittata rest for 5 minutes before slicing. Serve immediately or slice and portion into separate containers to quickly reheat as needed.

# From your Doral Village Board

I feel I should repost this from a couple months back with a few changes I made.

For those of you that are staying in Doral for the summer. REMEMBER; you are now in Hurricane Season.

# <u>IF AN EVACUATION ORDER IS GIVEN BY PINELLAS COUNTY, ALL MOBILE HOMES MUST EVACUATE!!</u>

**NEW 2022** <u>Pinellas County Hurricane Preparedness Guides</u> in English or Spanish are available **NOW** from the Office, the Clubhouse or ask a Board Member how to get one.

Make plans **NOW** for **YOUR** response to an Emergency Evacuation Order from the County. When the Evacuation order is given, you may have no more than a day or perhaps two to prepare; so, prepare prior to the Evacuation. Think about the following issues that YOU are responsible for.

- 1. WHERE are you going to go? NO BUILDING in DORAL is rated for shelter. YOU must arrange to stay with relatives or friends or hotels or designated shelters. The main water valve to the Park will be shut off during an Evacuation.
- 2. WHAT do you need to take with you? Insurance Documents, Ownership Documents, Medications etc.
- 3. DO you have a Pet or other Animal(s)? Only certain shelters and certain hotels will accept animals depending on their policies and the size of the animal.
- 4. HOW are you going to get there? Do you have a car or a friend with a car?
- **5.** WHAT do you need to do to lock up your unit and remove loose items from outside (They could fly away during a hurricane!). Shut off water valve and water heater.
