HEAT RESPONSES:

B ecause of our age and the intense temperatures we are experiencing these days; it would be beneficial to review procedures in the event you feel unusually hot. Heat related illness can be dangerous if not addressed right away. **Cramps** are the first sign that would suggest dehydration. If cramps occur move to the shade or go into an air conditioned setting and

drink Gatorade mixed with water because water dilutes the sugar content. Heat exhaustion signs show as very heavy sweating. This stage is serious. Get into the shade, untuck/unbutton the top around the neck, roll up long sleeves and sit in a cool spot drinking water in sips to avoid vomiting. Heatstroke is the most serious symptom. There is no sweating but the skin becomes bright red with a flushed face, a slurring of words and slow response to questions occur. This condition requires an immediate call to 911. Meanwhile, apply cold compresses to the groin, armpits and back of neck to lower core temp. Stay cool and monitor yourself.

Sometimes taking a 15 minute time-out is useful. Perhaps a quiet walk or examining your routine helps to reassemble who you are and what you need. An
