



Taking a Closer Look at Edema

welling in the body can happen for many reasons. Summer heat can cause your arms or legs to swell if you've been

Sitting or standing for a while. Body parts can also swell from overuse or an injury. But sometimes, swelling is a sign of an underlying medical condition.

More than half your body is made of water. Much of it flows around in your bloodstream. Water also makes up a lesser-known fluid called lymph. Lymph travels through the lymphatic system, which is made up of the tissues and organs that produce, store, and carry immune cells.

When your body fluids build up in one place, it can lead to swelling. This is called edema. You can get edema anywhere in your body—your feet, legs, ankles, hands, or even face. It can appear in one place or in many body parts at the same time.

Sometimes it's only temporary. Pregnancy can lead to swelling in the legs and ankles from the pressure of the baby. Eating too much salt can cause you to retain water. So can certain medications, like some used for high blood pressure.

"Edema can cause problems with moving around, discomfort, infections, and difficulty with wound healing," says Dr. Dhruv Singhal, a surgeon who treats lymph system problems at Harvard University. "So, any kind of swelling should be looked at by a health care provider."

Edema may be a sign of a serious medical condition. A dangerous type of blood clot called a deep vein thrombosis, or DVT, can cause sudden edema. Heart, liver, or kidney problems can also lead to swelling.

In a disease called congestive heart failure, the heart has problems pumping blood around the body. This can cause fluid to pool in the legs. With liver or kidney damage, fluid can't pass through them quickly and can build up in the limbs.

Trauma to the body can also trigger edema. Singhal treats a type of edema caused by damage to the lymphatic system. This is called lymphedema. In the U.S., lymphedema is most often caused by cancer surgery.

Treatment for edema depends on the cause. If the swelling is caused by a drug, switching to a different type of medication may help. People with edema caused by a blood clot usually receive a blood thinner to break up the clot. Drugs called diuretics may be used for conditions like heart failure. These help your body get rid of excess fluid.

"We also have certain treatments that almost all patients get, no matter what the cause of their edema is," Singhal says. These include compression garments: stockings, sleeves, or gloves that help reduce swelling. They can help reduce discomfort even if the cause of edema is something that can't be treated. or minor swelling that's getting worse over time, see a health care provider right away. Early treatment for many types of swelling can reduce symptoms in the long term, Singhal explains.

To Help reduce discomfort from swelling:

- Wear loose clothing and shoes that aren't too tight. The exception is when your doctor recommends compression garments. These are meant to be tight.
- Prop up swollen legs. Raise your feet up when sitting or lying down if you have edema in your legs. Keep them above the level of your heart if you can.
- Exercise gently. Moving the part of your body with swelling can help with symptoms. Ask your health care provider for safe exercises to do.
- Limit salt in your diet. The sodium in salt can cause the body to retain fluid. Check food labels for sodium content.
- Take medications as prescribed. If your doctor prescribes medication for edema, take it exactly as instructed.

Scam Phone Pitches Logged Recently

Fraud Watch Network Helpline, with names and details changed to protect individuals' privacy. Can you detect the signs that they are fraudulent? Remember: Impostor fraud,



in which criminals pretend to be law enforcement, government officials or other authorities, is now the number 1 type of consumer scam in America. The better you are at detecting it, the safer you become.

Scenario 1: "Hello, is this Mrs. Perl? This is Bill from Genetic Testing Services. Your doctor reached out to us because he is concerned with the cancer that runs in your family and would like you to take a DNA swab test. This test is covered by Medicare, and we just need your Medicare number to process and ship out the order."

Advice: Hang up ... when you hear any request for your Medicare number. This is a scam aimed at billing Medicare for unnecessary tests, many of which it does not cover.

Scenario 2: "Good morning, this is Apple Inc. We are calling to tell you there is a problem with your phone, and someone has placed malware on it. We will need you to download AnyDesk onto your phone so we can help you."

Advice: Hang up ... when anyone you do not know thoroughly asks for remote access tocontinued on page 25

your phone. Scammers are looking to steal personal information for identity theft or fraud.

Scenario 3 "This is Agent McMurphy from the IRS, and I am calling to inform you that you have a federal arrest warrant for not paying your taxes. Please press 1 on your keypad to be connected to my desk so we can clear up this matter."

Advice: Hang up ... on any call that you believe is coming in as a computerized robocall. IRS employees will never demand money or threaten you over the phone. They may call to set up appointments or discuss audits, but only after trying to notify you by mail.

Scenario 4: "Nana, it's me, Henry. I was away for spring break and got arrested because my friend was driving was drunk and we hit a pregnant woman! Please don't tell Mom and Dad. I need your help."

Advice: Hang up ... and reach out to your grandchild or another family member to check this out. This is almost certainly a form of the "grandparent scam," which uses personal information about your grandchild gleaned from social media to fool you. Don't panic and send money or reveal any banking or financial information.

Scenario 5: "Hello, sir, this is Amazon Security calling to inform you that there is an attempt to order items on your account. But don't worry — we can help with the refund. I just need a few pieces of information from you to get this started."

Advice: Hang up ... when asked for information to access your bank or other private accounts remotely. If you think there could be a problem, go directly to your Amazon account and contact the company directly through its website.

Scenario 6: "This is Denver Energy Company, and we are notifying you that you have missed your last two payments and unfortunately your electricity will be shut off by the end of today, unless you can pay immediately over the phone."

Advice: Hang up ... when threatened over the phone, especially by a robocall. Utility shutoffs aren't handled that way. You would get notification in the mail.

Scenario 7: "This is the Social Security Administration, and your Social Security check has been frozen due to fraudulent activity. Press 1 to take care of this matter."

Advice: Hang up ... when any federal or state government official suggests you need to pay them money over the phone or asks for personal information during a call. That doesn't happen.

If you haven't registered on the National Do-Not-Call Registry at donotcall.gov or 888-382-1222, do so. This will cut down on legitimate telemarketing calls, making it more likely that calls that do get through are scams. And when in doubt, let your answering machine or voicemail






