

ur Survey on Travel Trips has been completed for the most part. The bulk of those who responded have submitted their interest. Of the 186 emails sent out to our 280 members (some members have 1 email contact for two people) we received 79 responses. Below is a recap of those responses. Bear in mind if there was a "yes" responses it could be for two or more at an email address and the reason for a lower total response then the 280 members. If there was a "No" response to a trip or they did not select that option it is not reflected. Remember some of the responses are one response for two people. This might indicate for example, if 40 are interested the total passengers could be in the range of 60 to 80 people.

Those Mushrooms

Jody Larson

In July lots of mushrooms popped up in the lawns, probably because we got more rain. Those mushrooms are not edible, and could make a child or pet very sick if eaten, so be careful.

A mushroom is the above-ground part of a fungus—what biologists call a *fruiting body* that makes spores. Fungi aren't plants, and they can't use sunlight to make their own food. Instead, fungi absorb nutrients from the soil and from roots of plants, as well as from decaying matter.

Sometimes mushrooms grow in a line, and often these lines follow a tree root just underneath. You may also see mushrooms in a ring where spores have spread out from an original, long-gone mushroom.

It used to be that "mushrooms" were edible, and "toadstools" were poisonous. This is not a good distinction, because they all can look alike! In fact, some of the most poisonous mushrooms look very much like edible ones.

Once in New Hampshire I saw a beautiful, pure white mushroom beneath a tree, bathed in a ray of morning sunlight. It was an amazing sight and very attractive. But I felt a shiver as I recognized that the mushroom was a deadly *Amanita* species. Mushroom poisoning by *Amanita* is almost always fatal, and it takes a couple of days after eating it to get sick. The toxins destroy the liver and kidneys.

The best rule is not to eat any mushroom growing wild. Even experienced fungus hunters have been known to make deadly mistakes.
