

This next item is one you've probably all seen, but it's worth rereading because it's so true.

#### **HOW TO GIVE A CAT A PILL**

- 1. Pick cat up and cradle in your left arm as if holding a baby. Position right forefinger and thumb on either side of cat's mouth and gently apply pressure to cheeks while holding pill in right hand. As cat opens mouth, pop pill into mouth. Allow cat to close mouth and swallow.
- 2. Retrieve pill from floor and cat from behind sofa. Cradle cat in left arm and repeat process.

- 6. Kneel on floor with cat wedged firmly between knees, hold front and rear paws. Ignore low growls emitted by cat. Get spouse to hold head firmly with one hand while forcing wooden ruler into mouth. Drop pill down ruler and rub cat's throat vigorously.
- 7. Retrieve cat from curtain rod, get another pill from foil wrap. Make note to buy new ruler and repair curtains. Carefully sweep shattered figurines and vases from area and set to one side for gluing later.
- 8. Wrap cat in large towel and get spouse to lie on cat with head just visible from below armpit. Put pill inside end of drinking straw, force mouth open with pencil and blow down drinking straw.
- 9. Check label to make sure pill not harmful to humans, drink one beer to take taste away. Apply band-aid to spouse's forearm and remove blood from carpet with soap and cold water.
- 10. Retrieve cat from neighbor's shed. Get another pill. Get another beer. Place cat in cupboard, and close door onto neck, to leave head showing. Force mouth open with dessert spoon. Flick pill down throat with elastic band.
- 11. Fetch screwdriver from garage and put cupboard door back on hinges. Drink beer. Fetch bottle of Scotch. Pour shot, drink. Apply cold compress to cheek and check medical records for date of last tetanus shot. Apply whiskey compress to cheek to disinfect. Toss back another shot. ### **Hints**




