One 4 ounce package of watermelon gelatin

1/4 cup boiling water

1 - 12 ounce frozen whipped topping thawed

2 cups cubed watermelon seeded

1 graham cracker crust

Add the boiling water to the watermelon gelatin, let cool. Fold in the whipped topping.

Add the seeded cubed watermelon. Then pour all the mixture into the pie shell. Refrigerate for two hours then enjoy.



#### **Lemon Ricotta Pasta with Peas**

8 oz. Orecchiette pasta

1-1/2 cup whole milk ricotta

3/4 cup of grated Parmesan cheese

Juice and zest of one lemon

3/4 tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. Pepper



Cook pasta according to directions on package. About two minutes before pasta is done add frozen peas. Reserve 2 cups of the pasta water before draining. While pasta is cooking, combine ricotta, Parmesan, lemon juice, 2 teaspoons of lemon zest, salt and pepper. In a large bowl add half of the ricotta mixture to pasta along with 1/2 cup reserved pasta water. Toss together. Add more of the reserve pasta water as needed to make a smooth sauce. Top each serving with additional dollop of ricotta mixture.


