ope everyone is staying cool enough during these hot days of summer. Just a couple of thoughts for you this month:

- The property inspection sheets have been going out. These inspections were done about a month ago, so if you have completed the work, let us know and we will make a note of it. These have been done for ALL properties and are being distributed as time allows.
- The water project for the north side is moving right along! They have 2 more streets to hook up the houses to the new piping. We have received a map of all the new lines and cut off spots, so future repairs will not impact on the entire north side.
- Pinellas County is starting to fine people that are feeding stray/feral cats or animals because it is against the law to do so. Cats spread disease; defecate and spray on properties; and claw furniture. The county will no longer pick up cats, but you can trap them and take them to the shelter on Ulmerton. Live traps can be purchased at Harbor

Freight for around \$30.00. You can also call Friends of Strays at 727-522-6566 to see about renting a trap The number to call to report a person feeding animals outside is 727-582-2600.

• We have resubmitted the budget for the concrete slab and new fencing around the roll off dumpster on the south side. We are hoping this will be completed in the next couple of months.



## Lots of self-care, not much to show for it

## Many live in multigenerational households

ultiple generations sharing a single household is more and more common in the U.S. these days, and that doesn't seem likely to decline anytime. The Pew Research Center reports that the number of people living in households with family members has quadrupled from 1971–2021, accounting for 18% of the U.S. population and 59.7 million people in March 2021.

Young adults make up the biggest portion of this population. Com-Family Jr pared to previous generations, they tend to stay in school longer, delaying marriages and putting off creating their own households. Thirty-one percent of adults 25–29 live with their parents or relatives—37% of men and 26% of women.

Aside from financial factors, a third of adults live in multigenerational setups because of caregiving needs, with 25% caring for an older relative and 12% involved in child care. Other reasons include a change in relationship status (15%) and companionship (12%). Thirteen percent cite COVID-19 as their reason for living with several generations.


