

he board directors thank those of you who participated in the weekly July meetings and presented changes to consider in amending the Park Prospectus.

The ELS Regional Manager has given the board a "boilerplate" prospectus to use as a guide in preparing our proposed Prospectus Amendment. The boilerplate contains many restrictions to legally protect ELS. It is the board's objective to amend it to be a more cooperative document which also identifies benefits ELS will provide the residents. Prior to submitting the amended prospectus to ELS for their legal department review, it will be presented to Lake Haven home owners for review and approval. This review and approval process may require multiple revisions before obtaining home owners approval. We appreciate your patience as this may prove to be a long-term project.

Community Manager Penny Riley-Garcia has hired additional personnel to assist in the Lake Haven Community office – Lori and Donna. Please feel free to drop in the office to welcome them.

In addition, Penny was successful in obtaining funding to repair the safety hazard portions of sidewalks in Parks #2&3. Three former managers had damaged areas identified but the repair work was never started. Our thanks to Penny for following through to alleviate this safety issue. Penny has also met with the lawn maintenance contractor and addressed the need to improve the quality of their service.
