To remind some and bring others up to date, the remaining male swan was the last of four that were hatched here from a mated pair, Scarlet & Grey that were brought to the park from Ohio about 10 years ago by Roger Rex and Jerry Zimmerman of Bay Street.





Acquiring this two year old female has not been all that easy and there was talk of getting a pair of black swans until prices in the multi-thousands directed searchers toward what had been an annual auction held at a Lakeland Mute Swan facility. The search changed again when it became known the next 'annual auction' might not be until 2024. Persistence was rewarded when a female was found to be available in the panhandle and special thanks to Richard and Jamie for making the trip to get our newest addition to the Front Pond.

From the moment she arrived the couple have taken a liking to one another. There have been some changes to feeding arrangements to discourage the ducks. The Gateway Swans are given special feed that is bought and paid for from a special fund administered by the Homeowners Association. Donations can be made directly to the fund through the HOA treasurer.





DEALING WITH SCAM TEXT MESSAGES

y now nearly all of us with an email address have received one or two or dozens of emails offering thousands of dollars to help a Nigerian prince get his fortune into and out of your bank account or maybe one for a cash card and couple hundred or even a thousand to help the grandkid fix a car.

Well seeing as how apparently we are using text messaging accessed through our phone number rather than our emails, the scammers have resorted to 'texting' their cries for favors or offers for rich rewards or in some cases are simply engaging in harassment formerly known as 'prank calling'. Why not? This was the thing



that bored children, out of school for the summer, would do while mom & dad were off at work for the day.

Example: Text message alert. Message: 'Bill? What you up to? Bob.' People can find names and personal phone numbers with simple google searches. Well, it is one thing if you don't know any Bob but something else when you do and the next thing you know you can be chatting (texting) back and forth with someone up to no good. It make take some time but eventually you come to realize the person on the other end is not who you think it should be. End Chat Session.

Fortunately, just as we have the ability as consumers to report 'scam' emails there is also a way to report scam or prank text messages:

Where do I report a scam text?

Report it on the messaging app you use. Look for the option to report junk or spam. Copy the message and forward it to 7726 (SPAM). Report it to the Federal Trade Commission at ReportFraud.ftc.gov.

How do I forward a text message to 7726?

Press the message (be careful not to activate a link) Choose Forward (from the menu) Forward to 7726.

How to forward a text message from your phone to 7726

Touch and hold the message.

Select More.

Select the message you want to forward, then select the arrow in the bottom right corner. Enter 7726.

Select Send.


