





My name is Marty Ott and I live at #340 on India. I have been appointed the "Neighborhood Watch Liaison" for Serendipity MHP by the HOA and Pinellas County Sheriff's Department. My responsibility in this position is to take calls from the residents of Serendipity and give weekly feedback to the park manager and the PCSO Neighborhood Watch Commander, Deputy Chuck Skipper.

### July 2022 Notes from the Neighborhood Watch Coordinator:

No calls this month concerning the Neighborhood Watch. I don't know if this is due to no suspicious activity or fewer residents in the park during the summer. I can only respond to people who call me. If you have any questions regarding the volunteer position I hold, please call me personally. I would be happy to discuss my role in the safety of this park.

Just a reminder if you see something dangerous or feel threatened, call 911. If it is just to report something suspicious, call the Sheriff's non-emergency number at (727) 582-6200. Then call me the next morning at (727) 787-3272 and I will note it in the daily log so that we can categorize the types of problems we are having, and the Sheriff can assign manpower to our park at times and places necessary.

Serendipity residents should ONLY CALL me during regular business hours which are 8:00AM - 5:00PM.



# Things That Make You Go...Hmmmmmm?

### **SHRINKFLATION**

Tith the advent of rising inflation, another term shrinkflation has arrived on the scene. Shrinkflation is the practice of reducing the size or quantity of a product while the price of the product remains the same or slightly increases. Increased manufacturing costs due to inflation could be the reason. Shrinkflation is nothing new. As a child, I remember going to the movie theater and buying a box of Tootsie Rolls and finding the size of the roll was getting smaller.



Some recent examples of shrinkflation are:

- 1. The product All detergent, bottles went from 40 fluid ounces to 32 fluid ounces.
- 2. Kleenex box went from 65 sheets to 60 sheets.
- 3. Quart size Gatorade went from 32 fluid ounces to 28 fluid ounces.
- 4. Old El Paso taco seasoning mix is about 14% less.
- 5. Folger Coffee Classic Roast went from 51 ounces to 43.5 ounces. Folger claims a new bean is lighter but makes more coffee than the old bean.
- 6. General Mills shrunk family size cereal boxes from 19.3 ounces to 18.1 ounces.
- 7. Wheat Thins went from 16 ounces to 14 ounces or 20 fewer crackers per box.

One of the most interesting examples of a form of shrinkflation was in the service industry. A survey taken shows that 8 out of 10 people that deliver meals, sample some of the food of the customer. Have you been missing some pepperoni slices from your pizza?



propel themselves and a team to the playoffs or even stardom like status. However, the intense devotion displayed by these fans can sometimes lead to violence. Banter between fans may turn to insults, a fistfight, and before anyone knows what's happening, it escalates into thousands of angry fans running through the streets destroying property, burning cars, and injuring or in some cases killing people.

We have seen the benches empty in baseball games for a disputed call, bad pitch, or perceived slight towards a player. We have seen spectators rush the field after a football game to destroy goal posts and hear about the night's riotous celebration on the following morning news. While we have read or heard of these near riotous celebrations. Deaths are usually not part of the story.

Referencing a list of the 15 Deadliest Sports Riots of All Time, Detroit finds itself listed 3 times. In 1984 Detroit's celebration of winning the world-series turned into a riot with 1 death and 30 injured. Winning the NBA championship in 1990 saw Detroit's revelry become a destructive riot killing 8 people. Then the riot in 1993 due to Detroit's loss to the Chicago bulls resulted in two deaths.

Soccer fans were responsible for 11 riots on the list. It seems that many soccer clubs have



cultivated a devout fan base whose passions often seem to get the better of them. These 11 riots were scattered around the world and started over a lost game, a bad call, a scuffle between fans or just an intense dislike for those on the other side. In some cases, rioters did not limit themselves to using their fists or feet. Groups of rioting fans have used rocks, knives, bottles, and fireworks as weapons. Some people were beaten to death, others killed under the weight of collapsed walls or stands, and others trampled to death under the melee while trying to flee. The number of deaths per riot ranges from 2 to 320 deaths with many more injured in each instance. However, they pale in comparison to the riot that held the number one position.

By 532 AD the capitol of the western half of the Roman Empire, Rome, had ceased functioning as a seat of government for the western empire for 56 years. In 476 AD Emperor Romulus Augustus of Rome was deposed by a revolt of Germanic people that lived in many parts of the western empire. The leader of this successful revolt, named Odoacer, conquered all of Italy. He then sent the emperor's imperial crown, scepter, and all his robes to the emperor of the eastern empire with a message saying: 'We no longer have need of these, or an emperor here in Rome'. Rome was never again a seat of government for the Roman Empire.

The emperors of Rome had used various games to help appease the population for centuries. The largest facilities ever built for these games were the Colosseum and Circus Maximus in Rome. Gladiatorial games drew many spectators with a few gladiators developing a considerable fan base. However, their fame seems to have paled in comparison to the race car drivers of the day, the charioteers. The Circus Maximus of Rome was no longer the pinnacle of chariot racing after the collapse of the western empire. Now the Hippodrome in Constantinople (Istanbul), the seat of government for the Eastern Roman Empire, became the largest and most important location for a charioteer. Considered a very dangerous sport, charioteers, could achieve fame and fortune, and possibly retire wealthy if not killed or maimed.

The usual number of chariot races per event were 8-12 with up to 24 on special occasions. There were three driver categories: under 17, 17-23, and over 23 years old. Usually 12 participants, representing 4 teams, would race at a time, each team represented by the color blue, green, white or red. These factions gained some political clout over the years but the green and blue factions, supported by politicians and aristocrats, had greater influence with the emperor.

Seven laps around the approx. 1000 ft. track, about half the size of the Circus Maximus of Rome, completed a race. The prized seats to watch "shipwrecks", slang used to describe crashes, were at the curved ends of the track. Betting was rampant and there were very few rules, just about anything was permitted. Spectators even threw objects (nail-studded curse boards) at drivers to impede their progress around the track, and altercations between gangs of fans often spilled into the streets.

The emperor lived in the Great Palace, which was connected to the Hippodrome, so the emperor could safely walk to his loge when attending circus events. The emperor frequently attended the games. It gave public an opportunity to see and communicate with the emperor, and the emperor an opportunity to gage the mood of the populace and to solidify his position. On January 13, 532 AD, the crowd's displeasure was not pacified resulting in a massacre known as the Nika riot.

Public tension was running high. Justinian was in negotiations with the Persians trying to end an unpopular war. He had increased taxes and instituted many new laws, to pay for the war, that



made it impossible for aristocrats to bend legal judgements in their favor. People lost jobs and money due to these changes. The crowd in the stadium that day was also highly agitated because Justinian had refused to pardon two individuals, from different colored teams, of committing murder during a riot several weeks earlier.

Sometime during the day, the crowd's pleas for mercy for these individuals changed to chants of Nika, Nika, which has



Several senators and members of the blue and green factions, dissatisfied with the recent governmental changes, thought the chaos presented an ideal time to depose the emperor. Justinian was seriously thinking of abdicating his throne and leaving the city. However, his much younger wife, Theodora, was not willing to flee and berated him. She is credited to have said; "Those who have worn the crown should never survive its loss. Never will I see the day when I am not saluted as empress." She is also credited with adding, "Who is born into the light of day must sooner or later die; and how could an Emperor ever allow himself to be a fugitive."

Justinian regained his composure and devised a plan that involved a popular eunuch and two generals. The eunuch went into the Hippodrome with a bag a gold. He saw as many as a couple hundred dead bodies scattered about the stadium while approaching the leaders of the Blue Faction. He reminded them that Justinian favored them and then distributed the gold amongst them. While the Green faction was crowning their new chosen emperor, many of the Blues stormed out of the stadium. The two generals with Imperial troops, then came into the stadium and indiscriminately killed anyone that remained inside, Blue, or Green. It is estimated that about 30,000 people (about 10% of the city's population) were killed that day, and many of the supporters and senators that supported the riot were eventually executed or exiled.

The Nika riot crushed the power of the factions. The Hippodrome was closed, and the races suspended for five years, decades later the sport's popularity declined. The emperors found it increasingly difficult to finance the Hippodrome games while constantly fighting the Persians, and later Arab invaders.


