HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS 2022

obile homes are always the first places to get evacuation orders in the threat of an upcoming hurricane. It's best to know your risk and make a plan now.

Historically, hurricane activity in our Tampa Bay area is most active in September and October. The storm names for 2022 include the following:

After the named storms are exhausted, the Greek alphabet is used. In 2020, there were 30 named storms. The same list repeats every 6 years and names are only removed or replaced after significant damage or devastation occurs for that storm name (ex. Andrew, Irma and Katrina).

A hurricane has the following characteristics:

- 74 mph or higher winds.
- Can be hundreds of miles wide.
- Spins counterclockwise around the eye

According to BayNews9 Storm Season 2022 broadcast, there is some good information to help Tampa Bay prepare. A list of items to buy and have ready now includes:

1. A multi-task flashlight that also has a cell phone charger







- 2. A flashlight that stays plugged into an electrical socket and comes on automatically when the power goes out
- 3. Clear or opaque plastic sheeting to cover your windows while still letting light in
- 4. Plywood option deals/coupons/ product availability for online shopping from major retailers can be found at Honey.com

If a storm threatens our area, you will find real-time information on the Emergency Management website at: www.pinellascounty.org/emergency, including evacuation orders, shelters that may have opened and the current status of the community.

Though newer mobile homes may be built to higher wind codes, surrounding homes may not be. Mobile homes are vulnerable to flying debris/trees and, if not anchored properly, can become dislodged.

Actions to take to prepare now: Sign up for the Special Needs Program at www.pinellascounty. org/specialneeds

for residents of all ages who are dependent on electricity or require medical assistance such as oxygen or assistance with routine care.

Special transportation needs - If you need assistance with transportation, you must be registered. Use the special needs shelter form (same link) to indicate your transportation needs.

Pet-friendly shelters

There are pet-friendly shelters available for you to go to with your dogs and cats. You must stay at the shelter to have them there.

- Food is available for the pets at the shelter, but you may want to bring your own.
- Bring a carrier or crate and have a leash and collar, food and water bowls, litter box and litter, medicine and any comfort items.
- Pets will be in a crate in a separate area of the shelter from you.
- Put a picture of you and your pet, along with any special needs, on your crate. Preregistration is not required.
- A Pet Shelter Enrollment Form is available on the Pinellas County Animal Services website at <u>www.pinellascounty.org/animalservices</u>. Fill it in and tape it to your pet's crate. It will make registration easier once you get to the shelter

According to the Hazard Guide for Pinellas County, this is the "TO DO" list for being prepared:

- Create a complete checklist for pets. Create a checklist of important papers. Create a checklist of items for disabled or elderly persons, and pets.
- Create a list of items that you must take with you or store safely in waterproof bags or boxes if you evacuate.
- Make a list of tasks to perform outside of your home. Make a list of tasks to perform inside of your home.

Before the event:

• Take photos or video and inventory your property. You will need this if you have to make a *continued on page 8*



claim.

- Make sure you have all of your important documents together.
- Back your photos and documents up electronically using cloud-based storage

If the power goes out for six hours...

If there is food in the refrigerator, move perishable foods into an ice-filled cooler. Put a thermometer in the cooler to make sure it stays below 40 degrees. Meats and other perishable foods can stay about 40 degrees for two hours without spoiling.

If the power stays out for two days... If there is food in the freezer, it can be stored safely for two days if you keep the freezer door shut. Once the storm passes, cook any unspoiled food outside and consider sharing with your neighbors. From this point forward you will need non-perishable food. Get more information on food safety at

FYI -Other tips to prepare your refrigerator/freezer:

- \checkmark During hurricane season keep freezer and refrigerated items down to a minimum
- ✓ Fill large zip lock bags with ice and store them in your freezer and keep cooler chests handy (inside house), clean and ready for use also small bags of ice are good to use for muscle strains, swelling and/or injuries
- ✓ Go through all refrigerated items and check for expiration dates throw out anything that has already expired
- \checkmark A hand held can opener is a must have, for when the power goes out
- ✓ Clean out pantry of expired food items; re-stock with canned and ready-to-eat packaged goods that you can take with you, if evacuating
