





to sustain their staffs' clinical skills. This should not affect the VA but there is also some downsizing there also.

In a <u>report sent to Congress</u> on July 1, Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness Gil Cisneros said that the number of facilities scheduled for downsizing has changed and active-duty family members might be kept in the military system, depending on location and training needs. The plan gives 29 clinics the option of keeping some active-duty family members "as appropriate for provider skill sustainment."

The facilities will "generally transition non-active duty Service member Primary Care to the purchased care component of the Tricare program," including the provider network and those in Tricare for Life, the defense health program that serves as a wraparound for Medicare, according to the report to the congressional defense committees. But unlike the original recommendations, all 29 will "enroll active-duty family members as appropriate." The changes are part of an effort that began a few years ago to reform the military health system to slow the rising cost of health care, sending more patients to the private sector, paid for by Tricare, and focusing military providers mainly on active-duty personnel and training. The DoD process called for downsizing or closing dozens of hospitals and clinics. According to the report, the military treatment facilities will continue to care for patients until they have a primary care manager.

Visitors at the VA will be required to: Take a COVID antigen test (BinaxNOW), which will be administered by a staff member from the CLC, prior to visiting a resident. Visitors should enter at building 101 entrance. Visitors will be assessed for COVID-19 symptoms and have their temperature taken at the door. Visitors will be given a Level 3 mask to wear while in the CLC. Visitors will be taken to the library area and have a COVID antigen test performed by a licensed staff member. Visitors will wait approximately 20 mins for the test results.



If the result is negative: Visitors will be asked to exit the CLC and re-enter the CLC at building 71 Pedway Entrance. Visitors will sign in and obtain a visitor badge. Staff will be contacted to escort the visitor to the place of visitation. Visitors should complete hand hygiene before and after visit. Visitors will keep their mask on during the entire visit.

If the result is positive: The visitor will be asked to leave the CLC and encouraged to seek medical assistance from their personal provider

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #51

ast month we looked at the dry skin conditions of aging. Now, the more we know about skin cancer and the precancerous warning signs the better prevention and actions needed if we notice something suspicious on our skin. Remember that we live where sunshine gets to our skin many hours a day. Even with the shades and curtains drawn tight.

Some background first. Skin cancer begins in the cells that make up the outer layer (epidermis) of our skin. Skin cancer is the abnormal growth of skin cells most often develops on skin exposed to the sun. Though some groups of us seem more susceptible. Me too.

Melanoma (our focus here), basal cell skin cancer and squamous cell skin cancer are the most common types found in seniors. Melanoma is a disease in which malignant cells form in the skin cells called melanocytes which gives us our skin color. When skin is exposed to the sun, melanocytes make more pigment, causing the skin to tan, or darken. When melanoma starts in the skin, the disease is called cutaneous melanoma and can occur anywhere on the body. Risk factors for Melanoma are unusual moles, exposure to natural sunlight (even inside our homes, sunlight still invades around curtains and blinds), exposure to artificial ultraviolet light (tanning booths), history in the family, Caucasian, being an adult, certain features like blond or red hair, light skin and freckles too. Whew!

What do we look for and how often. Checking for moles, new or already there twice a year looking for a difference in how it looks, getting larger, changing shape or color. Does it itch or bleed often. Seeing smaller and similar moles around the larger suspicious mole. By the time we retire we do have a lot of skin tags, moles and scars. More often you inspect the more you know these old ones you seen for years.

I cannot stress enough that we are the first line of defense with noticing problems with our skin that is bothersome. We so often see our physician's medical team where a more thorough skin examination seems to take second or third place in the visit if at all. Ask for a skin examination at each yearly visit and especially if you are concerned! Ask a friend to look at your back too. You do their back too. Take a phone picture if you can. Most people can't escape getting a skin exam if they are seeing a dermatologist. Hold still as it won't hurt!

What is the next step if our medical team is concerned about a spot, mole or lesion on our skin? Most often a referral to a dermatologist. If there is concern on whether it is an abnormal skin growth or even in a high probability area they will typically do a biopsy. After numbing up the skin area they will do a local excision to remove as much of the suspicious mole or lesion as possible. A pathologist then looks at the tissue under a microscope to check for cancer cells. Melanoma can be hard to diagnose which can mean another biopsy or additional office visit. We should not shave off or clip off suspicious looking areas as this can delay identification if cancerous and in some cases increase the spread. Be smart and call your medical team.
