Note from The HOA Board of Directors

(Please take a few minutes to review the information below)

Te are busy planning behind the scenes getting ready for the many activities we all can enjoy in the coming months. We are still looking for someone to chair or even help out at the Halloween & New Years Eve Party. Craig Rodgers and LeeAnne McHugh have stepped up to chair our Thanksgiving event.

Change can be difficult, but at times it can also be good. We continue to look for volunteers who are willing to serve and help where needed. For those volunteers who continue to help, we applaud you. Donna Miller and her group of volunteers who help with BINGO on Monday evenings and Rose Hendershot who continues to serve in the kitchen, to name a few.

Some have asked what the HOA does for the community. Its purpose and responsibility is to oversee that our neighbors, as well as ourselves, live in a community that was started before we purchased our home and to be sure management and Lautrec are doing their part for our community. We also try and encourage all residents to follow the Prospectus that was signed prior to moving in. The Board has seven members and all members have had some type of business background. The Board works with management to improve the amenities we have around our community. We also negotiate any lot rent increase by Lautrec and in the last negotiations, the actual increase was far less than originally proposed. Any issues that come to the Director of Complaints are taken seriously and are treated as a priority. Craig seeks solutions as quickly as possible. Although we may not have immediate answers, that does not mean it is not being handled behind the scenes. We as board members live in this community and want it to be as nice as you.

If a resident has not joined your HOA, please consider joining. The board continues to work with management and Lautrec in a number of areas as well as new amenities for our community. We continue to look at ways to work with Management in keeping our community a beautiful place to call home. Please reach out to Patty Peterman if interested in becoming an HOA member. The cost is only \$15 annually.

Management shared that a number of residents have reached out this past month to discuss or share their concerns. We as a board are happy to hear residents see that Management does want to hear from them. Although the answers may not always be what they want, management has the opportunity to explain why and possibly come up with an alternative solution.

New Prospectus

Il residents have now received a copy of our new Prospectus revised by Lautrec, Inc. Numerous questions have come up about some changes. Many of the changes are just housekeeping type changes but the following are changes in the rules of Amber Glades. By law, these changes are allowed and take place 90 days after notification to residents. (Oct. 22, 2022)

- A change was made about children hours at the pool since the old one left out the 5-7 pm
- Skateboards are now prohibited on the streets or sidewalks of the park.
- Old Prospectus had walking dogs on Diamond only this has been taken out.
- Overnight parking has been changed to be enforceable by towing. Residents will receive phone call for first Incident – towing if resident violates again.
- Golf carts Licensed drivers only.

HUMANA FOOD TRUCK

The HOA has arranged the Humana Food Truck to stop at our park once every month to subsidize needy residents with food. It is scheduled for the 3rd Monday of every month at 3:00 pm. If you would like a sack of food items or know of someone that could really use the extra food, please come to the clubhouse on the scheduled days. If the board gets the names of residents in need, we will arrange a sack for them so just call or tell any board member who could use this service. September date will be September 19 at 3:00 pm sharp!

RECENT SCAM

ecently, many residents in the park received a text message asking them to do the writer a favor – usually the Board President or a friend of the person getting the email. The favor was to buy gift cards and the writer would pay for them when they picked them up. The Board President has been working with Pinnellas County to trace where this original text came from. They are very close to tracking the sender down and determined the text probably came from within the park.

Lesson: If you get a request from a friend asking for anything, call them before doing anything to make sure its really them. If you get a text or phone call for something too good to be true – it probably is a scam. Don't spend any money for home repairs, etc. without talking to someone familiar with the company. If you have a question about something, call the nonemergency number for Pinnellas County Sheriff's Office and ask if its valid.

It was a powerful message: Don't settle for "doing your best." A leader's responsibility is to accomplish his or her task—no excuses.
