n August 5th a group of 40 residents gathered at the clubhouse to witness the ballot counting for Spectrum bulk packaging for the park. The resident ballots were verified by Board Members Michelle Johnson and Bob Waldorf and then passed along to an independent notary who tallied the results. There were 196 Ballots received, 14 were not able to be verified as residents and 2 were duplicates. The total count was 140 No bulk cable and 40 Yes to cable. Immediately following the meeting, an email was sent to management with the decision by the majority of the residents. The bulk cable packing will not be pursued any further.
