



trash and yard waste must be bagged or bundled. Cat litter needs to be in its own bag and tied up. Shredded paper and filters are NOT recyclable. It is considered trash. The hours at the maintenance yard are Monday-Friday 7:00am-9:00pm Weekends and Holidays 7:00am-1:00pm. **Prepare for Hurricane Season ahead of time**

If you are leaving Ranchero for vacation or any other reason, make sure everything is picked up around your home. That includes fruit off the ground, lawn furniture, grills, and any other loose object that could be blown around by the wind. Hurricane information is inside the Hacienda Clubhouse by the office.

HOME BOUND RESIDENTS

If you need assistance to leave your home in the event of a mandatory evacuation, there is a form on the Hurricane Table located in the Hacienda Clubhouse that you should complete and mail in. You can also call 727-464-3800 for more information.

PARKING, TRAFFIC AND MOTORCYCLES

All motorized vehicles are required to be registered with the office.

Motorcycle ownership in Ranchero Village shall be limited to eight percent (8%) of the total number of homes in the community. In addition, Meetings of motorcycle groups involving non-residents are not allowed on Community property without approval of management. Please be mindful of your neighbors while leaving and entering the park. Please try and do it as quietly as possible, so to not disturb your neighbors.

Parking regulations: The number of motor vehicles allowed per Home Site, excluding guest vehicles, shall be limited to space available to safely park in the carport. No continued or extended parking on the grass at home Sites or common areas.

Golf carts and other motorized vehicles must only be given by adults sixteen (16) years of age or older. Owners of golf carts are responsible for their use and must register with the park office.

Parking in Cul-de-sacs is restricted to cul-de-sac residents and their guests.

At no time will vehicles be allowed to be parked on vacant lots or sidewalks.

Parked vehicles shall not block or impede access to or from Resident's carports or cul-de-sacs.

Parking in carports other than your own is prohibited unless written permission is granted by the other homeowner and reported to Management.

Vehicles must park so as not to restrict the passage of emergency vehicles.

Parking rules violations may result in the vehicles being towed and the charges for such towing shall be owed by the owner to the towing company.

SPEEDING IN THE COMMUNITY

There have been many complaints about the speeding in the Community and the running of Stop signs.

Speed limit for all vehicles is 15 miles an hour. The carport/driveway is for parking cars not storage.

We need your help to stop the violations, if you see someone doing any of the above, please submit it in writing to the office with the lot number.

FRUIT SEASON BRINGS PROBLEMS

The citrus trees are beginning to bear larger fruit and it is an attractive morsel for furry vermin. Fruit rats feast on the fallen fruit as well as fruit on the tree. Pest experts give us this advice to help control the varmints. 1. Keep your yard simple and don't make it a jungle paradise. 2. Don't feed birds outside. Rats love birdseed. #. Seal holes and cracks in doors, window frames and walls. 4. Get rid of clutter, including old furniture, newspapers, and boxes. 5. Pick up fallen fruit, daily if necessary. 6. Keep your garbage can closed and don't put the curbside containers out until the morning of collection. 7. Work with your neighbors to ensure that their yards are rat free, too. If your neighbors have rats, you'll have rats. 8. (You won't like this one) Snakes are your friends when it comes to rat control. While snakes can't solve all rat problems, they do enjoy eating them. Hawks and owls are good ratters, too.

Do not feed any wild animals, this includes ducks, birds, and cats. If you are feeding ducks, you may get fined by Pinellas County if someone reports it. It is against Ranchero Village rules and regulations.

GUESTS

Guests staying more than 1 week MUST be registered in the Community Office.

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping, or diving into the pool.

The Corral Pool is the only pool with children's hours. 10:00am-11:00pm.

SELLING OR RENTING YOUR HOME

Please give the office a 60-day notice if you are going to sell or rent your home. All homes will be inspected to assure they are complying. We also require a copy of the rental agreement with the name, monthly fee, and length of time the home will be rented to this person.

RENTERS

It is the responsibility of the homeowners to make sure that any additional occupants in their homes are properly registered with the park. If you are planning to rent out your home or have someone stay with you, review your Ranchero **Rules and Regulations** first. **PET RESTRICTIONS MUST BE OBSERVED BY ALLAND APPROVED BY MANAGEMENT BEFORE A PET CAN BE BROUGHT INTO THE COMMUNITY.** Additional occupants and renters must be registered with the office and a background check performed <u>prior</u> to their arrival. It is the Homeowners responsibility to meet all the requirements. There is an application fee to cover this expense. Applications are available in the Office. They must be accompanied by two legible forms of identification for each person. For international applicants, copies of passports and driver's licenses are required. These should be submitted at least 30 days in advance of the person's arrival. Renters are to check in at the office upon arriving in the community.

IF YOU ARE A RENTER OR ADDITIONAL OCCUPANT and haven't done the above,



please come to the office immediately and get properly registered. Thank You! <u>SOLICITORS</u>

DO NOT let them into your home! Call the Largo Police Department (587-6730) immediately if you see solicitors and please let the management office know after you have called the police. If we can get a license plate number, it would help immensely. Management has been working with the police in an attempt to stop these offenders. Ranchero is a plainly posted No Soliciting Community; no one should be coming to your door. These people are very bold and brazen; please help us stop them and any other solicitors before they take advantage of anyone in our community. The office NEVER gives permission for anyone to solicit.

<u>GLASS BOTTLES</u> – It's time to enjoy the pool and the beautiful Florida sunshine. PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out and the pool will be closed until it is cleaned.

<u>Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub</u>. People have been seen eating on the side of the pool and having their drinks inside the pool and hot tub. Please do not do this. <u>ICE</u>

Ice is located at each clubhouse. As a courtesy please be sure to pick up and discard any ice cubes that fall on the floor.

<u>No smoking at the pools</u> – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas. This includes vapor and e-cigarettes.

<u>**Hot tubs**</u> – these are for the use of <u>**adults only**</u>. No one under 18. Do not use the hot tub or pool if you are not feeling well or have open sores.

HOME SITE ALTERATIONS

If you are making any changes or additions to your home site or the exterior of your home, please come to the office and submit a completed request form. Paint colors must be approved, and a permit obtained from the office. The same applies to alteration requests; this includes plantings and any changes on the outside of the home. Submit your written request and wait until you have received approval and a permit before proceeding with any work. Also, be sure to obtain any required City permits.

DOG WALKING

Keep those plastic bags handy when walking your dog. Be a good neighbor and properly dispose of pet waste. Please stay on the dog section side of the street. Do not let your dog up on neighbor's property.

All requests and complaints should all be put in writing and signed. Anonymous reports will not be addressed. Forms are available in the office for your convenience
