Dear Fellow Residents:

Reminders:

- Please keep your properties neat and clean.
- If you are contemplating changes to your homes, please remember to notify the Board and get an approval on record.
- Please check your homes for water leaks. These affect all of the shareholders.

Pinellas County Water Proposal: There have been several email blasts regarding the Pinellas County proposal to replace the water and sewer system in LSR. A town hall was held on 1 Aug in the hall and via zoom with two representatives from Pinellas County to answer questions from the residents. Thanks to all who participated.

The Board plans to hold a shareholder vote as soon as possible on the county proposal.

Office and Library Termites: Termites were found in the library and office. This appears to be an early infestation. The building will be "tented" starting on 11 August for two to three days to eradicate the termites.

Water Usage: Water usage continues to be near historic lows for the community.

Electric Usage: Our electric bills are on the rise. The park is currently over budget for the year. Please make sure to shut off lights if not needed.

- Acorn Tree Service trimmed the palms in the park. In the process of trimming, Acorn noticed that the large oak at the front of the park is diseased and may have to eventually be removed. The Board will seek additional advice since this tree is a feature of the front gate.






