You will notice 3 new cabinets just below the TV screen. DVD's have been sorted and categorized for your selection.



cup + 2 tablespoons of all-purpose flour 1/4 teaspoon salt 6 tablespoons granulated sugar 1/2 egg 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips

6 tablespoons packed brown sugar
1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

#### Directions

- Pre-heat the oven to 375 F (176 C).

- Stir in the flour mixture until just blended (the dough will be stiff).
- Stir in the chocolate chips and nuts if you're adding those.
- Drop the dough by the rounded tablespoonful onto ungreased cookie sheets, about two inches apart.
- Bake 8 to 10 minutes or until light brown (the center will be soft).

Board of Directors Meeting are held at the convenience of the 7 elected Directors. They are usually held on a monthly basis. Purpose of each meeting is set by the current business only and specified in the monthly Agenda prior to the meeting. Meetings maybe be cancelled due to lack of important business or a quorum of Directors.

Per FL Chapter 723, the "Agenda" must be "posted" no less than 48 hours prior to the meeting which at the present time is in the Mailroom. Lincolnshire HOA has also provided, but is not required, to send out the notice via email to all HOA members at the same time. Presently, there are 13 members who have not provided an email address or don't have one.

Decorum at any meeting is governed by Robert's Rules of Order. A member may speak at a meeting on Agenda items only and will be recognized during the discussion on their particular issue. A sign in form is provided for that procedure, provided you arrive 10 minutes early. The Chairperson at the meeting may recognize a non-board member for a question of clarification during the meeting, provided it is brief and pertains to the discussion at hand.

Any member can submit a new issue in writing for the Board's future consideration. Members must understand that they cannot involve the HOA in an individual owner's dispute with the Property Manager. However, we can assist with information based on current Fl Statutes and Rules and Regulations as well as normal practice & procedures.

meetings are closed for Directors only.

<u>Membership Meetings.</u> The <u>Annual Membership meeting</u> is mandatory by FL state laws for all Condominiums, Homeowner Assoc., Time-Sharing, etc. Lincolnshire is scheduled for February of each year. The purpose is to amend, add or delete By-Laws, receive year-end financial reports, Officer Reports on yearly projects, Standing Committee reports, etc. Not connected but usually held at the same time are General Election of Directors.

Lincolnshire HOA Bylaws also allow for January & March membership meetings as needed.

All Membership meetings require a <u>14-day advance notice</u> and a 25% Quorum by attendance and/ or proxies. Annual Membership Meeting require written Agenda & Proxy delivered to your residence. If an Election is required, a Ballot will also be included.

Special Membership meetings can be called at any time as required.

<u>Annual Mediation Meetings</u>. Held annually following the announced Lot Rent Increases and Rule Changes. A committee of five (5) Members is selected by the Board of Directors. They can be at least three (3) Directors and two (2) non-Directors but members in good standing.

By FL Statute 723.037 4(a) and at the request of the Board, the meeting will be held no later than 60 days before the effective date of the change of the Lot Rent Increase, at a mutually convenient time. This meeting is attended by the HOA Committee – the HOA Attorney – Lincolnshire Management – Rickert Property Owner/Representative and their Attorney.

This meeting is Closed to all others.

The purpose of the meeting, .... "to discuss the reasons for the increase in lot rental amount, reduction in services or utilities or change in rule and regulations" ..... "... and may include in the request a listing of any other issue, with supporting documentation, that the committee intends to raise and discuss at the meeting."

## **VETERAN'S CORNER**

Retirees and military family members who have identification cards with no expiration date can choose to upgrade to the new Next Generation Uniform Services Identification, or USID, cards whenever it's convenient -- if it's done within the next four years, according to the Defense Department. There is no looming deadline for use of those old non-active-duty cards without expiration dates, but the department expects to completely phase out and replace them with the next-generation IDs, by 2026, says Maj. Charlie Dietz. In the meantime, cards with expiration dates are required to be replaced within 90 days of elapsing. The Defense Department began the effort to update all those IDs to the new format in July 2020, but the changeover hit delays caused by the pandemic. After 2026 only the USID card will be the only card accepted for installation and benefits access.

The USID format for military retirees and dependents represents the first change to those identification cards in nearly 30 years; the last update was in 1993. The new design closely resembles the Common Access Card, or CAC, format issued to active-duty troops and department civilians. But there was uncertainty among those with cards that list the expiration as indefinite. The IDs are needed to access military facilities and to confirm eligibility for various military benefits, so missing a deadline or losing the identification could disrupt cardholders' lives. Expired cards can be confiscated at base gates.

Those with cards with no expiration dates "may have the card replaced at their convenience," according to Dietz. The department recommends they go to the ID Card Office Online and use the office locator to find a site that issues the new cards and book an appointment. Retirees and their dependents, dependents of active-duty troops, reserve members and Medal of Honor recipients are among those who will receive the USID cards.

The other good news about the new Common Access Card/ID Card is that it will now work at all TSA checkpoints at all U.S. Airports. Your CAC/ID card could take the place of your State License/Real ID Card. The new cards will not have a built-in chip like the current cards do but they will have a durable lamination, full-color photo and enhanced security features, making them less likely to be counterfeited.

Did you know that you can honor your Veteran that has passed or still living by purchasing a paver to be installed at the city of Largo's Military Court of Honor at Largo Central Park? For just \$100, you can purchase a custom-inscribed 8-inch by 8-inch paver. All pavers purchased

by March 15 are installed by Memorial Day. Purchases made between March 16th and September 1st are installed by Veteran's Day. You can get the form and instructions to order by going to your browser and typing in Military Court of Honor Paver. Scroll down and you will see the PDF form to download.

ast month we took a look at the basics of skin cancer and treatment. This month, a quick look at the longer-range issues that skin cancer can cause. Florida is a true Sunshine State.

Why be so concerned about skin cancer. Our skin is our most protective outer organ, yes, it is an organ. The skin's responsibility is defensive and holds us together. Our outer skin cells fall off and the layers underneath move out. Happens 24/7/365 non-stop. Dust mites around our beds wouldn't exist without this. Sorry, it's true.

As we age and have exposure to nature's elements like the sun and other chemicals, some of our skin cells begin to get confused or out of control. Why we get more dry skin, skin tags and those ugly barnacles. When those cells begin to alter their structure and reproduce rapidly then cancer is a primary cause. These cancerous cells can also travel to other areas of our bodies both in the skin and internally. Our body is a vast network of turnpikes, freeways, and back roads.

So, our primary doctor doesn't like what they see and send us to a dermatologist. They will decide if a biopsy is needed, or topical medications are wanted too. There are creams that are also chemotherapeutics that can destroy the abnormal skin cells. Usually these can be done by us twice a day or once using a "blue light" to activate them. Our skin gets a bit irritated by these chemo creams so know it may itch etc. Creams are only used if the abnormal skin cells are on the surface. There are also creams that simply dry up the skin cells within a week.

When the Dermatologist recommends a biopsy of the area or is concerned, they will recommend a biopsy, either small or include an area well outside the lesion. If the biopsy finds cancerous cells the repeat surgery will be much wider attempting to remove all cancer cells. Often those cancer cells will migrate. Cancer cells don't ask permission to travel!

Simply be prepared to have a larger area removed then you can see!

Cancer cells can migrate and hitch a ride almost anywhere in the body. Chemotherapy and radiation may be required if there are multiple internal and external areas affected. "Staging" of the cancer is simply where it is and the effect on our body. Also determines treatment.

My simple message is this: exam your skin with help from a partner, spouse, or friend. Often, we must be our own advocate! Examine front and back. A spot is irritating and not going away, see your primary physician. Don't have a primary physician, get one today. I did say "today." Most skin cancer or lesions if treated early don't diminish our lives.

Tally Ho! Next month how "falls" are mostly preventable and can change our life, dramatically. Stay tuned. Oh, what is my favorite source online for medical information? WebMD. Not an endorsement though information language is accurate and understandable.


