Neighborhood Watch


My name is Marty Ott and I live at #340 on India. I have been appointed the "Neighborhood Watch Liaison" for Serendipity MHP by the HOA and Pinellas County Sheriff's Department. My responsibility in this position is to take calls from the residents of Serendipity and give weekly feedback to the park manager and the PCSO Neighborhood Watch Commander, Deputy Chuck Skipper.

I can only respond to people who call me. If you have any questions regarding the volunteer position I hold, please call me personally. I would be happy to discuss my role in the safety of this park.

August 2022 Notes from the Neighborhood Watch Coordinator:

Calls received this month were all related to concerns of trespassing (people walking through yards). Remember there is a rule in the Prospectus stating that you cannot walk through other yards without permission of that homeowner, and this is only for daylight hours, never at night.

I've received an email from Deputy Chuck Skipper stating that in the Palm Harbor area alone, one night during the week of July 31st, there were 7 vehicles burglarized and 2 vehicles were stolen. The real problem with <u>ALL</u> these vehicles is that they were unlocked. More than 80% of vehicle burglaries or theft are due to unlocked vehicles. Fortunately, none of these were

Just a reminder if you see something dangerous or feel threatened, call **911**. If it is just to report something suspicious, call the Sheriff's non-emergency number at (727) 582-6200. Then call me the next morning at (727) 787-3272 and I will note it in the daily log so that we can categorize the types of problems we are having, and the Sheriff can assign manpower to our park at times and places necessary.

Serendipity residents should **ONLY CALL** me during regular business hours which are 8:00AM - 5:00PM.

UFO UPDATE

ast July, believe it or not, was the 75-year anniversary of the Roswell UFO incident. The final government version was a weather balloon with wooden dummies testing high altitude jumps. After an intensive review of the topic, my understanding is quite different. A couple of days after July 4,1947, two UFOs collided with each other in a severe thunderstorm near Corona, New Mexico which is close to Roswell. One flew off in a westward direction and crashed against a rocky bluff. It was not found for two years with no survivors. The other UFO became the Roswell craft that bounced against the earth, shredding debris on a sheep ranch. It crashed about two miles away from the original impact area with one survivor, who was named Ebe (extraterrestrial biological entity). That is what I gathered happened at Roswell and is the start of the modern-day UFO phenomenon as we now know it. President Harry Truman gave the incident a security clearance higher than that on nuclear weapons and the government cover up on the subject began.

A lot of UFO incidents have happened since then throughout the world. On June 25,2021 the U.S. government issued an eleven-page report on UAP (Unidentified Aerial Phenomena). I will continue to use the term UFO (Unidentified Flying Object). The report was based on 144 reports of UFOs around our naval fleets and training areas. The report basically said that the objects were real but what they were and where they came from is unknown. Also, they were not anything that we had. One of the events happened in 2004, or 18 years ago. You mean with all the intelligence agencies we have with billions of dollars in their budgets they could not say it is not from Russia, China, or the U.S. Suggesting that it might be extraterrestrial was not even mentioned. The words "other source" is used. It was the first time in decades that the federal government said anything about UFOS since shutting down "operation Blue Book" in 1970. The report said more reporting would follow. Congress also got involved in funding the government unit investigating UAPs. Funds were also requested for medical expenses for personnel involved in sighting these UAPs and coming down with illnesses and burns. Evidently some of naval aviators came back with radiation burns after sightings. This report was followed almost a year later by an opening hearing before a House of Representatives intelligence committee.

On May 17,2022 an open hearing was held by the House of Representatives on UAPs (UFOs) seen around U.S. nuclear powered naval vessels over the past 18 years. This was the first hearing before Congress on UFOs in the past fifty years. Not much more was said that was not covered by the report of one year ago. Although the number of incidents reported increased to 400. The two government representatives at the hearing were under-secretaries of the Department of Defense. The questions they were asked by the congressmen were good. The answers from the two Defense Department representatives were pathetic. They seemed like they weren't briefed on the subject. If you don't want to disclose anything you send people who don't know anything and that's what the government did. At least they admitted the UFOs were real, but origin is unknown. There will be more meetings soon and more will be known. Edgar Mitchell, NASA astronaut and lunar commander on Apollo 14 moon mission, has summed it up; "I happened to be privileged enough to be in on the fact that we have been visited on this planet, and the UFO phenomenon is real."

Chocolate SKOR Bar Cake Recipe

1 Betty Crocker (or similar) Devils Chocolate cake mix, or Chocolate Fudge cake mix. Make cake according to box.


ICING:

1 large container of whip cream (1 liter?)

3/4 cup icing sugar

3/4 cup Cocoa Powder

4 SKORE Bars



I sometimes put 1/2 packet or 1 full packet of unflavored gelatin into the whip cream just before it's firm. It helps to keep the icing from going soft)

While the cream is cooling, break the SKOR bars into small pieces.

(I hit them with a hammer while they are still in their individual packages)

Whip cream until firm.

Gently fold in 3 broken SKOR bars into the whip cream.

Ice cake, saving the remaining SKOR bar to sprinkle on top of the cake.
