HURRICANE SEASON 2022

Hurricane season starts June 1 and runs through November 30th.

Now is the time to plan what you will do if a Hurricane is forecast to hit the Tampa Bay area. If an evacuation order is issued, Palm Hill is a mandatory evacuation zone as are all mobile home communities. Should you choose to remain in the park and need medical or emergency assistance, the authorities will not respond as they will be dealing with other emergencies, and you should have heeded the evacuation order.

The nearest shelter is Largo High School 410 Missouri N. Largo; this is a pet friendly shelter but will fill up quickly. The 2 Clubhouses here in Palm Hill <u>are not</u> rated as hurricane shelters and therefore cannot be used by residents as a shelter. Due to Liability issues both clubhouses will be locked down when an evacuation order is issued.

Ensure that your gutters are cleaned out and any pots, chairs, planters, or anything that may become airborne are stored either in the shed or inside the mobile. Maintenance is responsible for ensuring that the common areas are secured.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION STICKER

Palm Hill decal – this has pink palm trees with a registration number on it. This decal must be placed on the lower left corner of the windshield (drivers' side) on the inside. This is in reference to Rules X. PARKING RULES, Section G.

If you do not have a decal, please go to the office with the following information

- 1. Name
- 2. Park Address
- 3. Vehicle Make & Model
- 4. Year
- 5. License Plate #
- 6. State or Province
- 7. Replaces Vehicle (if you need a new decal/sticker due to purchase)

NOTE – No Commercial Vehicles are to be parked overnight on Cooperative Property without authorization from the Park Manager.

VISITORS PASS

A ll vehicles owned by visitors to Palm Hill must have a Temporary Parking Permit. This permit must be visible on the dashboard of the vehicle when it is on Palm Hill property. This includes the resident's driveway, overflow parking, clubhouses etc.

This permit must be obtained prior to the visitor arriving. The resident must know the arrival date and departure date of said vehicle and the address of the resident being visited.

Golf carts are not to be operated by anyone under the age of 16 even with an adult.

DRIVER COURTESY REMINDERS AS SEASONAL RESIDENTS RETURN

HOAA, NELLIE! Speed Limit is 15 miles per hour. Watch speed around corners, especially as you get close to the Park's exits/entrances. Like a horse that breaks into a run when he sees the barn up ahead, sometimes our cars speed up when nearing the Park exit roads. Hold on to those reins! And take care when passing areas of heavy traffic: the pools, the golf course, the clubhouses, the post boxes.
