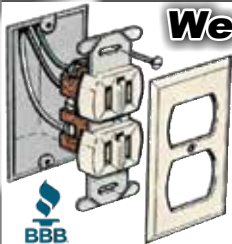

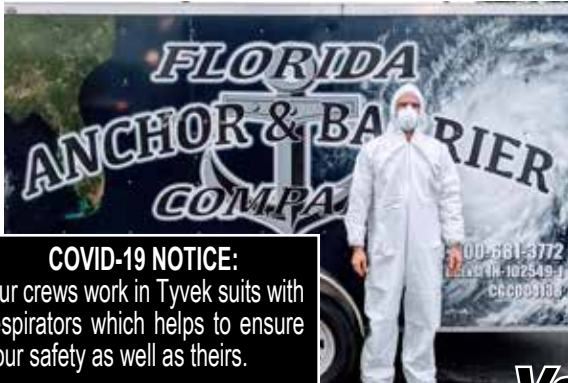

The People You Meet on a Hiking Trail!

There are few activities I enjoy more than a good hike. Whether strolling a shoreline trail in one of Connecticut's state parks or exploring a mountain meadow in the Grand Tetons, hiking delivers a host of benefits: healthy exercise, connecting with nature, beautiful views, the companionship of fellow hikers. One of my favorite places to hike is in the Adirondack Mountains. I have spent a lot of time on the mountain trails of upstate New York's highest peaks, and one of the most interesting aspects of this pursuit is the people I have encountered on the trails. A few that stand out in my mind are the family who was hiking all the mountain trails barefoot (we nicknamed them "The Hobbits"); a man drinking from a Jack Daniels bottle who was clearly ill-equipped to be heading into the wilderness alone (fortunately he allowed us to gently turn him back); and the mayor of Saranac Lake who gave us a sales pitch on his community!

But one of the most interesting was also the most recent. Earlier this summer my hiking buddy, Fran, and I were getting ready for a short climb up Baker Mtn. We briefly chatted with two other men at the trailhead parking lot, then they set off ahead of us. Partway up the mountain, we caught up to them taking a rest and started to chat. Fran asked if one of them was a priest; they looked surprised, and asked how we knew. Fran replied that one of them had signed into the trail register as "Fr. Bryan," which was a pretty good clue! Turns out they were both priests, Bryan in the Roman Catholic church, and Jason in the Ukranian Catholic denomination. As we hiked and talked, Fr. Jason recounted a fascinating recent story.

One of his parishioners had never had children of his own. He and his wife had befriended a girl living in an orphanage in Ukraine and had hosted her at their home for several weeks over the Christmas holidays. When she returned to Ukraine, the man promised that if she was ever in trouble, he would help her. A month later, Russia invaded Ukraine. The man told Fr. Jason that he intended to go to Kyiv and get her out. Fr. Jason, fluent in Ukrainian, insisted on going with him. After managing to find the orphanage, they explained to the man in charge why they were there. He replied "There are 22 orphans here. You either take all of them, or you take none." Without hesitation, the man turned to Jason and said, "We'll take them all." A man of some means he had a private plane standing by, capable of carrying all 22 out of the country. As none of the orphans had papers, they were only able to get them to Lithuania. But at least they were all safely out of harm's way and officials there were helping to get the necessary documentation for further travel.

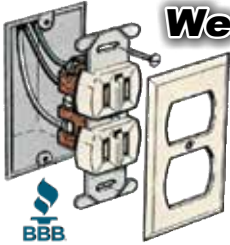

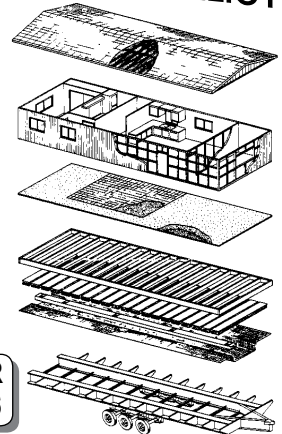

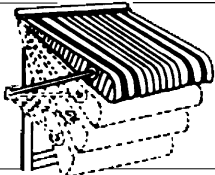
