BOARD BUSINESS AND UPDATES

Board immediate communication

Te have looked at the <u>mybriarcreek.com</u> email server and can see we only have 101 owners who have logged in and saved their email address. That means if an emergency or some form of urgent news needs to reach you 216 don't get the message.

While a water leak requiring us to turn off the water for a period of time may be the more common alert, we do sometimes need to send, on occasion, other important notifications you may want to know about immediately. Sorry but telephone calls do not work. Many do not answer their phones anyway. If we attempted to call those needing to get immediate information. To just call 60 people the timing is bad. The simple math is, it will take 5 minutes to dial the number, a few minutes to deliver the message, if you answer your phone or your voicemail is not full, a few minutes to answer your questions. Therefore, the simple math is 5 minutes to notify 60 units will take 300 minutes (5 Hours). The emergency is over.

Phone trees do not work, trying to get a phone captain for each street has not proven successful, plus if you don't answer or you are not home then someone doesn't get the message.

E-mail provides instant messages going out. Granted not everyone has email or you may not check it every day but if your water is off, you can find out who, what, where and when

it's coming back. Plus, with most water outages, we can plan in advance so you will know in advance and plan accordingly.

The Board of directors realizes there are other e-mail messengers in the community however they are not always available. Their list may include others not in Briar Creek Phase I. At least one director is available and will have the ability to get the message out, if there is information the community needs to know immediately.

If you don't have e-mail then get to know your neighbor, they may have e-mail and they can alert you to something you need to know about right away. You may have received a message recently from the board. This was a test to ensure the email addresses we do have are valid. If you did not receive a message from briarcreekoff@gmail.com then we do not have your address on file.

- 2. There is a website www.upcsportshub.com with a page dedicated to our travel club. This contains the trip information and includes more details on some of the trips. There is also an automated sign-up form on the travel page so you can sign up for a trip, or send information needed for some travel trips.
- 3. We will, on some trips, use the services of a travel agency to assist us with our trips. Our Travel Agent is there to assist you also however it's important to note the travel club needs to get the sign-up information first. Our agent often times may be away escorting other trips. They also assist and service many other organizations and may not be familiar with you individually. The Briar Creek Travel club uses the records we maintain on all trips to validate and confirm guests on our trips. Contacting the travel agency in advance could result in information being lost as we have no way to compare the trip manifest if you are not first listed on our manifest for the trip. Timing could be an issue if the agent is away from the office escorting another group.

Please contact the Briar Creek travel club first. Our Travel Agent can then contact you if any additional information is needed for the trip. For many trips, the Travel Club will maintain the funds until we know we have the minimum capacity necessary to meet the trip requirement. This makes it possible for the Travel Club to refund the trip cost to you if it's necessary to cancel a trip. Once we reach that threshold to pay for the trip, some trips may not be refundable but we can transfer the trip to another name as a replacement.

Age in Ireland and was called "Samhain" which in Celtic means "Summers End". The day is celebrated today much as it has been in the past. Bonfires are lit and all over the country, children get dressed up in costumes and spend the evening "trick-or-treating". After trickor-treating, most people attend parties with neighbors and friends. At the parties, games are played, including "snap-apple," a game in which an apple on a string is tied to a doorframe or tree and players attempt to bite the hanging apple. In addition to bobbing for apples, parents often arrange treasure hunts, with candy or pastries as the treasure. In Mexico, Latin America and Spain, All Souls' Day, is commemorated with a three-day celebration that begins on the evening of October 31. The celebration is designed to honor the dead who, it is believed, return to their earthly homes on Halloween. Many families construct an altar to the dead in their homes to honor deceased relatives and decorate it with candy, flowers, photographs, samples of the deceased's favorite foods and drinks, and fresh water. Often, a wash basin and towel are left out so that the spirit can wash before indulging in the feast. Candles and incense are burned to help the deceased find their way home. A few African countries are well known for their witchcraft and voodoo practices such as Benin, Togo, Ghana, Nigeria and the Congo holding on to their own ancient traditions, thus somewhat having a connection with Halloween. There have also been many witch stories arising out of Madagascar where worshipping the dead is very common. Every year, the dead family member's body is exhumed, the family members elevate the corpse above their heads dancing and singing in circles. The corpse's clothes are then changed for new clothing and the body is again wrapped in new sheets like a mummy before being reburied again until the following year's funeral anniversary. Just as many countries celebrate Halloween, others don't celebrate or have even banned Halloween, frequently for religious reasons. For example, some religions prefer to celebrate the idea of life versus focusing on death. So this year, while you are carving your pumpkin, consider taking time to explore other fun and unique Halloween traditions around the world.

Those Yellow Flowers in the Roadway Islands

ou may have noticed when driving in Oldsmar and Clearwater that some islands in the roads are filled with greenery that has bright yellow flowers. This plant is Perennial Peanut, a pretty groundcover that requires little maintenance and is hardy in our climate. Shorter ornamental varieties are best for this purpose.

Although not a Florida native plant, Perennial Peanut does well in full sun or partial shade. It requires very little fertilizer and is resistant to drought and to most pests. It blooms all summer long. Perennial Peanut produces no nuts, unlike its close relatives.

Many counties in Florida use this plant in their road islands because it saves on the cost of mowing and looks good year round. Perennial Peanut is also a good forage plant for horses, cattle, goats, and even rabbits.

Fortunately her main dresser wore the same size of shoes as the Queen and she had the interesting responsibility of 'wearing in' all the Queen's new shoes.
