

HISTORY OF PINELLAS COUNTY FLORIDA

hrough the centuries, the Pinellas Peninsula has attracted a diverse mix of people: Tocobago Indians, Spanish explorers, pioneer farmers and fishermen, real estate speculators of the 1920s, tourists, and since World War II, a tremendous influx of retirees and working people. Dramatic growth and urbanization since the war has made Pinellas the most densely populated and intensely developed County in Florida. Initially slow to develop due to its inaccessibility,



Pinellas grew rapidly following the arrival of the Orange Belt Railroad in 1887. Since that time, the County's consistent growth has been interrupted only briefly: During World War I, following the collapse of the Boom period of the 1920s, during the Great Depression, and during World War II. Among the most notable changes of the past 100 years: • Twenty-four municipalities have been created in Pinellas, ranging in population size from 78 to 249,068. • The County's population, often subject to dramatic rates of growth in the past, is now the sixth largest in Florida and the 41st in the nation. The median age of Pinellas residents, 43, is consistently higher than that of the state and the U.S., due to a substantial influx of retirees into Pinellas following World War II. During the 1980s and 1990s, however, the County's median age decreased by 3.8 years as large numbers of working-age people moved into Pinellas to take advantage of the County's employment opportunities. Undeveloped and agricultural lands, which dominated the Pinellas landscape until the 1960s, have yielded to urbanization as farms and citrus groves grow scarce. Over the decades, the County's economy has been influenced to various degrees by such diverse industries as agriculture, tourism, retirement, service, trade and manufacturing. The past decades have seen the decline in the importance of agriculture and manufacturing, with almost 60% of total employment concentrated in services and 18% in trade. As buildout approaches and remaining undeveloped land disappears, the County must deal with additional capacity strains to water systems, residential areas, parklands, and highways. As Pinellas takes steps to address present problems and future needs, renewed consideration must be given to the historic character and natural environment that continue to make the County a unique and desirable place to live and work.

CLEANING TIP:

lot or you probably already know, I clean houses for a living. I thought I'd include some cleaning tips in the newsletters. Just some things I've figured out to make cleaning jobs a lot easier. As well as products (mostly from Dollar Tree) that I find work really well.



If your unfortunate enough to have glass shower doors, here's a good way to get the soap scum and lovely Florida water stains off. Spray them liberally with cleaning vinegar. You can use distilled, but cleaning vinegar doesn't smell as strong. Let the vinegar sit on them for about five minutes. Then go over them with a damp magic eraser. Then wipe with a large thick towel. You may have to do them twice if it's been awhile, but this should clean them up pretty nicely. Then. . . go out and get yourself a squeegie and use it after every shower.

Quick note about magic erasers: (1) the cheap ones work just as well as the name brand and (2) although they are awesome at cleaning a lot of stuff that nothing else will work on... be careful with them. They will take the finish off your floors, glass top stoves, etc., and if using on wood work, go easy as they'll take the paint right off. Discovered the paint removal at one of my client's houses, and not my own. Yay...

RECIPE

LIVER AND ONIONS

Ingredients

2 pounds sliced beef liver 1 ½ cups milk, or as needed ¼ cup butter, divided



2 large Vidalia onions, sliced into rings 2 cups all-purpose flour, or as needed salt and pepper to taste

Directions

Gently rinse liver slices under cold water, and place in a medium bowl. Pour in enough milk to cover. Let stand while preparing onions. (I like to soak up to an hour or two – whatever you have time for.) This step is SO important in taking the bitter taste of the liver out. Melt 2 tablespoons of butter in a large skillet over medium heat. Separate onion rings, and saute them in butter until soft. Remove onions, and melt remaining butter in the skillet. Season the flour with salt and pepper, and put it in a shallow dish or on a plate. Drain milk from liver, and coat slices in the flour mixture. When the butter has melted, turn the heat up to mediumhigh, and place the coated liver slices in the pan. Cook until nice and brown on the bottom. Turn, and cook on the other side until browned. Add onions, and reduce heat to medium. Cook a bit longer to taste.



WHAT TO DO WHEN YOUR DOCTOR LEAVES YOUR HEALTH PLAN

s I write this, I am going through this with Florida Blue and Bay Care. Hopefully, by the time this is printed, they will have gotten it together. When you have a good **L** relationship with your doctor, it's almost like magic – especially if you've ever had a doctor you've disliked. After all, a good doctor-patient relationship can do wonders for the quality of your health care. You're more likely to be open and candid, and the doctor is more likely to listen closely and provide better care. And if you've been seeing the same doctor for years, they know your medical history inside and out. That's why it can be so disappointing to find that your doctor is no longer in-network, meaning your health insurance company no longer covers your visits, or covers much less of the bill. Although most people would love to stick with a trusted provider, out-of-network doctors' fees are often too steep to pay out of pocket. Some other reasons that can force you to cut ties with your doctor: Your employer drops your current plan, or your doctor retires or leaves the practice. If this is the case, you could: Change health plans to one that your doctor participates in if such coverage is available. However, it may not be among the plans you have to pick from, like those offered by an employer - Negotiate a cash price to continue seeing your doctor. The willingness of a doctor's office to do this and the cost and what's affordable for each individual will vary considerably - or set about finding a new doctor. Sometimes, entire health systems and insurance networks part ways when they can't reach an agreement over issues like physician reimbursement.

When Your Doctor Leaves the Practice

It's not unusual for doctors to enter and leave health insurance networks, or move to a different location or workplace. When your doctor does drop out of your network, you'll probably be warned. That means you might get a nice letter in the mail informing you of an upcoming change – or a bill after services are rendered for an amount way higher than your normal copay or insurance. Physician turnover is not uncommon. On average, primary care and multispecialty practices experienced slightly more than 10% turnover in a 2021 survey.

When Your Employer or Insurance Company Makes a Change

Another scenario is when options for employee health plans change or dwindle. When employers drop an insurance company, workers may find their doctor is no longer in their network. Insurance companies also can make business decisions that leave patients scrambling. Insurance issues over which patients have no control can disrupt long-held doctor-patient connections.

Easing a Physician Transition

If changing insurers, physicians or medical practices is inevitable, take steps to make the best of the situation: - Seek Referrals – Be Proactive, don't wait to start your search for a new provider - Transfer Medical Records - Understand Your Coverage, look at your policy and make sure you know what it covers.

Find Out if You're Protected

Depending upon where you live, you may be able to retain in-network-level coverage for



your doctor – at least temporarily – even if he or she leaves your network. Check to see what continuity of care protections your state has in place. Sometimes there are absolute reasons that you can't change to another doctor. Maternity care for a high-risk pregnancy and ongoing cancer care are among the most common reasons that insurers allow some continuity of care with a previous physician.

While protections vary, under these clauses, you may be able to continue paying the same copays and fees for your care until the baby is born or a medical condition resolves, for example, before you need to find a new provider. Continuity of care is also available in some insurance plans without being required by law. In these cases, patients with serious chronic conditions or terminal illnesses may also keep their providers for up to 12 months in order to make a safe switch.

Plan Enrollment and Switches

There's good news for the roughly 28 million seniors in Medicare Advantage Plans, private alternatives to government-run Medicare: Those with these insurance policies can, under certain circumstances, leave their plans mid-year if their doctors do. There also is the Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment Period which runs from January 1 through March 31 each year. This enrollment period allows you to switch Advantage plans or go back to original Medicare. You can switch plans during the Annual Open Enrollment period for Medicare, October 15 to December 7, as well.

RETURNING HOME AFTER AN EMERGENCY WITH YOUR PET(S)

fter an emergency, familiar scents and landmarks may have changed. Pets can become confused and lost, so it's important to keep pets on a leash or in a carrier when they're being transported or when you go outside. Some hazards for pets and people include snakes and other wildlife, especially after flooding, and downed power lines.

Returning home Check your home for sharp objects, spilled chemicals, and exposed wiring to protect your family and your pets from injury. The behavior of animals may change dramatically after a flood, flash flood,



thunderstorm, or hurricane. Normally quiet and friendly animals may become irritable. Monitor animals closely and only release them in a safe and secure environment. Contact a veterinarian if you notice any signs of stress, discomfort, or illness in your pets.

Finding a lost pet Make sure that your family is in a safe location before you begin your search. If you are in a shelter that houses pets, inform one of the pet caretakers. Give the pet caretaker a missing pet flyer. Many shelters and organizations will house pets lost during disasters. Contact your local humane society, animal welfare organization, or county or state animal response team to find the shelters or organizations near you. (Pinellas County Animal Services – 12450 Ulmerton Rd., Largo Tel: 727-582-2600.) In addition to shelters and rescue organizations, you can contact local animal control about your lost pet and post missing pet flyers in the area once conditions are safe. If your pet has a microchip, call the microchip company to let them know your pet is missing and make sure all the information about your pet is updated and current.

Pet first aid Emergency treatment and first aid for pets should never be used as a substitute for veterinary care. But, it may save your pet's life before you can get your pet to a veterinarian. Best Flowering Plants for Florida

Problem Volvulus Also called Blue Daze, evolvulus is a charming of groundcover that offers true-blue flowers, a rarity in the gardening world. Those sky-blue flowers look great against its silvery-green foliage. It blooms nonstop, making it valuable



for edging garden beds and borders or spilling over the side of a container garden. One quality that makes evolvulus such a good choice for Florida gardens is that it's drought tolerant. Once established it rarely needs watering outside of natural rainfall. If evolvulus has a downside, it's that its blooms are beautiful in the morning, but usually close up by noon -- so be sure to plant it where you'll enjoy it during the morning hours. Evolvulus typically grows about 6 inches tall and 12 to 18 inches wide. Grow evolvulus in full sun or part shade and well-drained soil. Fertilizing it helps encourage best bloom display.

Gerbera Garvinea gerberas offer daisy-shaped flowers in a wide range of colors. And they are loved by pollinators. The flowers hold up well indoors for bouquets, too. Most Garvinea gerberas grow about knee high and flower from spring to fall. Grow Garvinea gerberas in full sun or part shade and moist, but well-drained soil. Water during times of drought to keep them happy and fertilize regularly in spring or summer to keep them blooming profusely. They are perennials here in Central Florida.

Heuchera shows off fantastic mounds of colorful foliage that are perfect for adding texture and interest to deeply shaded spots. It's deer and rabbit resistant, too. There are a wealth of varieties available; Florida gardeners should look for selections that hold up well to heat and humidity, such as 'Bressingham Hybrids' or 'Melting Fire'. You can find heuchera with bold purple, bronze, orange, chartreuse, or green leaves. Most are appreciated best for their foliage, rather than their flowers. Most grow about 12 inches tall and 12 to 18 inches wide. Grow heuchera in shade in moist, well-drained soil. Once established, it's somewhat drought tolerant, but does best with consistent soil moisture. Spreading a layer of mulch over the soil helps keep it happy during times of drought. It thrives in both garden beds and borders, as well as containers.

Mexican Heather is a Florida garden staple that offers shiny, dark green foliage accented with charming lavender-pink or white flowers almost all year long. Though the plants look small, they form a dense and easy-care groundcover once they get established. And while you'll love that they're beautiful and low maintenance, bees and butterflies will love visiting the dainty flowers for their sweet nectar. Mexican heather is useful as a groundcover, in mass plantings, or as an edging plant in garden beds and borders where it thrives in the heat with practically no care at all. It grows 12 to 18 inches tall and 24 to 30 inches wide in time. Grow Mexican heather in full sun or part shade and well-drained soil. Once established, it's quite drought tolerant so you can just about plant it and forget it. In addition to thriving in landscapes, it's also good for container gardens. It's a perennial here in Central Florida.


