RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Pumpkin Soup

Ingredients:

6 cups chicken stock
4 cups pumpkin puree
5 whole black peppercorns
1 cup chopped onion
1 clove garlic, minced
1 teaspoon chopped fresh parsley



Directions:

I 1 ½ teaspoon salt

Place chicken stock, pumpkin puree, onion, garlic, salt, thyme, and peppercorns in a large pot; bring to a boil. Reduce heat to low and simmer, uncovered, 30 minutes.

Step 2. Transfer soup to a blender or food processor in batches; blend until smooth

Step 3. Return soup to the pot and bring to a boil; reduce heat to low and simmer, uncovered for 30 minutes.

I Step 4. Stir in heavy cream, garnish with fresh parsley.

FROM THE OFFICE



he rent Committee, comprised of: Ron Russell, Mike Matheny, Joyce Latuga, Angela Robinson & Ruth Cushman, met with Mr. Larson on Sept. 16th. Prior to that meeting, they had posted times that anyone with questions or concerns could meet with them, but nobody showed up. The rent letters will be in the mail by the 1st of October. The Clubhouse locks will be changed Sept. 23rd; anyone needing a key will have to sign for it in the office with the reason why they need it; if they are a snowbird, they will be required to turn it back in when they leave. Under no circumstances are they to give the key to anyone else to use without prior approval from the Office.

I am in the process of replacing the bulletin boards outside of the Clubhouse doors, details will be at future Manager meetings.

Rent is due on the 1st, late on the 5th; it is a flat \$30 late fee anytime after the 5th. The checks get deposited as soon as I can, but sometimes there is so much else going on that they don't get deposited right away. (I deposit everything I have before I go on vacation, then the rest when I return). Most of the banking is done from my home, as it is almost impossible to get it done during office hours. Please quit calling the office to ask when your check will be cashed! This then takes us time to check the system (record keeping book, computer system, deposit slips) and we just don't have this extra time.

I have been sending out letters every week regarding yards and carports. If you have scrap metal, old grills, appliances, etc. call Roy and he will arrange to have a scrap man pick them up. Do Not Put them to the street until he has verified what day they will be picked up!

Please refer to Park rules regarding when you can put ANY garbage out to the road. If you put it out early, and it gets rained on, the park will not pick it up and you will be responsible for taking care of it. Garbage or yard waste (which must be bagged, boxed, or bundled) is not to be put out to the street until after 5 p.m. on the day before pick up. So many residents, plus Park staff, work hard to maintain this Park in a way that they are proud to call home, and having garbage at the curb for days at a time makes it look trashy!





We are still having problems with residents who don't follow the rules regarding garbage: recyclables (boxes must be broke down and are NOT to be put in to the garbage dumpsters and garbage is not to be put in the recyclable dumpsters); large items, such as dressers, toilets, etc. must be broke down before being put into the 30 yard dumpster; if the gate is locked it means it is either full or out getting dumped....do not leave garbage outside of the gate!!! The ONLY place for construction scraps, such as drywall, paneling, wood, etc. is the 30-yard dumpster. The Park can get fined for the wrong items in the wrong dumpster, and we do not even have to provide the 30 yd. dumpster. If garbage problems continue into 2023, I will be looking into curbside pickup, which is more expensive so the cost will be passed on to all the residents in the form of a larger rent increase. I spend a lot of time working with Mr. Larson on keeping our rent increases reasonable (for the 2nd year in a row our increase will be \$5 lower than Bay Ranch). If you see someone not abiding by the garbage rules, I need the make, color, and license plate (Or golfcart description) of the offender so I can send them a letter. Repeated violations of the same park rule within any 12-month period can result in eviction! (if you can get a picture, even better....a picture is worth a thousand words). The pool deck will be refinished sometime in October, which will result in the pool being closed to a week....we have had to wait for cooler temperatures to do it.

FOOD EVENTS

First, there is no income limit, this is for any senior citizen. No resident should be the judge of whether someone should not be there because they think they know their financial situation! A lot of times unexpected events occur, such as needing to replace an appliance, car repair, medical bills, etc. so the food makes a big difference. Sadly, we have residents living on \$1,000 a month or less, so these events help them up the standards for what they have to eat each month.

Regarding the people who run this program, we all work together well as a team and volunteer our time, usually about 10 hours a week! If we need extra help, I have a few people who are ready to jump in and help out. Here is a quick synopsis of what my volunteers do for the Park: Ron Russell takes care of the flags, timers for lights around the clubhouse and on the boulevard, is an active neighborhood watch member, does Sunshine Lady duties, to just name a few.

Little Mike always makes the coffee for most functions and is an active neighborhood watch member, he constantly wipes off the tables in the clubhouse, etc. AND he's no spring chicken! Big Mike hangs all of the flyers when I need them done (a lot of times he reminds me), picks up garbage on the park streets and outside of the Park on Frontage road daily. He has had medical issues, including a bad back, but he still does what he can.

Joelle, being the youngest of our crew, has the strength some of us no longer possess and maintains a smile on her face while dealing with stupid!

Chuck does so much for the park that no one even knows; he saves Walter thousands of dollars every year doing repairs on the pool system; we recently had an issue and the pool company we use quoted a price of roughly \$1,000; Chuck ran around trying to find the part in stock, I finally had to order it from Amazon....the part cost \$20 and Chuck put it on for free. He often is a sounding board for Roy when he is trying to figure out a maintenance issue that has him stumped; he takes all of the bank deposits to the bank, he escorts people out of the park that do not belong here, etc.

Roy and the maintenance crew set up the tables, wipe them down before food is delivered, then take care of all the boxes when it is over, as well as the "bad" food that we sort out. They also help unload the vehicle when food arrives.

Jessie-if people do not realize all that I do that is not part of my job, shame on them! I also have severe back pain, but I suck it up to sort and display the food, having to take extra pain meds on food days just to get through the rest of the day. I also communicate with all the agencies that help provide the food, setting up dates, times, etc. Without my management, these free events would not be happening, not just the food, but the hurricane radio give a way, the free luncheons scheduled by the Doctors offices who help sponsor them, etc. Roy and I also buy the carryout containers and plastic bags used to break down large quantities of items.

To hear that residents have an issue with anyone from this crew taking food items as we setup was very disheartening, especially because I made the decision to not have everyone line up outside in the heat, so you are all sitting there seeing the effort it takes to make these events successful. We also put aside a few packs of cookies or bread to drop off at the homes of some of the 90+ years old people who can't physically make it. Some of you may be thinking "who would complain" but residents did make several snarky comments and went so far as to call a snowbird and tell them that the food the crew takes equals "stealing" from them. Shame on all of you who do not appreciate the effort that goes into the success of these events, you know who you are!

For the good people in the Park, we will not let these naysayers deter us, we will continue doing what we do!




