REMINDER: The Humana Food Pantry is scheduled to provide a bag of free food to anyone in Lake Haven who wants to participate in the program. Once again...please refrain from throwing large items in out dumpster area. It will make a difference in our disposal bill.


We are having our season opener BBQ park 3 membership drive on October 29th! Memberships are \$10.00 per person for the entire year.



No single answer to leadership


eadership consultant and blogger Tim Milburn likes to tell this story about the noted leader John C. Maxwell:
