
Our thoughts and prayers go out to our sick and shut-ins and to those who have lost loved ones. Bob


THOUGHT ON PLACES AND THINGS



FLUSH ONLY: Body waste and toilet paper. It is highly recommended that only one ply toilet paper be used to prevent clogging the toilet.



DON'T FLUSH: Tampons- Sanitary Pads – Diapers – Depends – Swiffer Cloths – Dust Cloths – Wet Wipes – Kleenex – Food, etc.

When we flush, the waste goes into a **holding tank** that has two pumps to expel the waste **<u>UP</u>** and **<u>OUT</u>** into the Pinellas Park sewage system. When any of the above gets flushed, it clogs the pump, overheats it, and burns out the motor.




