National Substance Abuse Prevention Month. Millions of Americans suffer from substance abuse, which includes underage drinking, alcohol dependency, nonmedical use of prescription drugs, abuse of over-the-counter medications, and illicit drug use. Early intervention helps prevent substance abuse and reduce the negative consequences of addiction before they occur.

Conflict Resolution Day, Oct. 22. Promoting awareness of mediation, arbitration, and other creative, peaceful means of resolving conflict in schools, families, businesses, communities, governments, and the legal system.

Moral: The things we overlook as simple and ordinary, that we take for granted, are the most truly wondrous.


No single answer to leadership

In anything that counts, success is based on lots of factors. Looking for one simple answer will rarely get you what you need.











What to know about monkeypox

onkeypox has become a global health crisis, with more than 28,000 cases reported around the world. According to NPR, here's what you need to know:



- Monkeypox is a virus. Its name comes from the fact that it was discovered in monkeys used for research in 1958, though that doesn't mean that monkeys are the source of the disease. It's similar to smallpox (which was eradicated by 1980 due to global vaccinations), but it's not as dangerous or easily transmissible.
- It's not necessarily fatal. The West African strain of monkeypox currently spreading across the world is serious, but it probably won't kill you. The CDC estimates that 99% of people who get infected will survive. Still, it can be deadly for children under eight, people with compromised immune systems, or people who are pregnant or breastfeeding.
- **Symptoms.** The symptoms of monkeypox include fever, headaches, muscle aches, and fatigue—similar to those of smallpox. It may also cause a rash or blisters anywhere on the body. The rash may appear before other symptoms, and can persist for two to four weeks.
- How it spreads. The virus is transmitted through close personal contact, including sexual ٠ contact as well as contact with an infected lesion. It can spread on surfaces, though that seems to be rare. Respiratory droplets can also spread the disease, putting health care workers and anyone living in close proximity with an infected person at higher risk. In general, though, the risk of catching monkeypox in the U.S. is considered low by the CDC.
- How to protect yourself. Avoid close contact with large groups of people. If you've been exposed, keep potentially contaminated items like clothing, bedsheets, and towels contained until they can be thoroughly washed. Wash your hands frequently. Keep track of the spread of the virus in your community.

Cutting back to afford health care

Delayed medical care or getting prescription drugs	38%
Driving less	26%
Cut back on utilities	10%
Skipped meals	7%
Borrowed money	6%

More than half of adults in households earning less than \$48,000 per year report having to cut spending to pay for health care, but they're not alone. In households earning \$180,000 or more, 19% also had to shave some expenses for medical needs. Women are hit harder, with 30% saying they've had to trim spending on health care because of the cost, compared to 20% of men.





Lies and the lying liars who tell them

et's be honest — everybody lies. In fact, a survey of 2,000 U.S. adults by One Poll for Online Betting Guide found that people tell an average of four lies every day, and suspect that other people lie to them six times daily.

When do people lie? Thirty percent say they lie when asked if they like what someone else is wearing, and 27% will lie if someone makes them a meal they don't like.

Are you a convincing liar? The survey, which focused on poker, found that only about 24% of people believe they have a good poker face, while 37% think they do a good job of misleading others. Only about one in 20 people say they have a bad poker face. On the other hand, 53% of people in the survey believe they can spot when someone is lying to them, and just eight percent say they're poor at it.

On the whole, 42% of people surveyed said they feel they have a hard time concealing their true feelings, and 54% said they consider honesty very important. Assuming they're telling the truth.

Social media distrust is widespread

f there's one thing we can all agree on in these divided, polarized days, it's that we don't trust social media with our personal data. The Washington Post reports that although social media is ubiquitous these days, 64% of Americans feel the government should rein it in.

Among the top social media platforms, Facebook is the least trusted, with 72% expressing little or no trust in its handling of users' personal information, with 20% saying they trust it a lot. That's

followed by TikTok, which 63% of social media users don't trust, and Instagram, with 60% trust.

Amazon seems to have earned the most confidence, with 53% of customers saying they trust it a great deal or a good amount, followed by Apple at 44% and Microsoft at 43%.

Fifty-six percent of people surveyed feel that Facebook has a negative impact on society, with only 10% finding it a positive.
