### FROM THE MAIN OFFICE

'm going to tell you a story and give you the steps to prevent this happening to you.

A resident of Teakwood listed their home with a realtor. Paperwork was dropped off at Teakwood Village Sales indicating that the home had been sold to a person who was approved for residency. The buyer did not come into Teakwood and complete the paperwork, so the seller was charged lot rent. The lot rent put their bank account into overdraft. Not a happy thing. Now let's talk about how to prevent this.

When you sell your home, please make sure to do the following:

Make sure to notify, IN WRITING, Teakwood Village Sales Inc. that you are selling your home. Once sold, again in writing, notify Teakwood Village Sales Inc. that you have sold your home, your buyer(s) need to have completed the Residency Application and been approved to live in Teakwood Village. If they are not approved, they must remove the home from Teakwood Village. You need to sign a form for Teakwood Village for your buyer to assume the lease of the lot or the above can happen to you. Each person on the title must be approved for residency and then be on the lease/rental agreement. Make sure to tell your realtor (if listing with an outside realtor) and your buyer that the buyer MUST make an appointment with Teakwood Village Sales (727-581-2628) and complete ALL the paperwork for renting the lot. If you have ACH with Teakwood Village for your lot rent, you need to cancel it, selling the home does not stop you paying the lot rent, only transferring the lease/rental agreement to your buyer (yes, this needs both signatures) will do so. If you list your home with Teakwood Village Sales, all of these items will be taken care of. Keep in mind Teakwood Village Sales is there for you. They are there to answer any questions you have about selling your home, whether with a realtor or selling by yourself. They will also sell your home for you and market it the same way any realtor would for a minimum commission. From our point of view, Teakwood Village Sales was established to ensure all homes are titled properly, resident applications are completed, and leases are property transferred.

Remember that selling the home does not terminate the lease for the lot. They are 2 separate things that need equal attention.



The Margaritas, regular and strawberry, were a unanimous hit. They are very large...you need two hands to pick them up and at \$10.99 they cost more than many of our entrees but were well worth it!



The menu is extensive, and everything is freshly cooked, so it takes a little time but again, it is worth the wait...besides we were enjoying our margaritas & munching on the fresh nachos and pico de gallo obligingly set out on the table. Among us we tried a couple different enchilada, chimichanga, burrito and taco salad dishes. One went straight for dessert and ordered the Fried Ice Cream. The portions were large and most of us took home leftovers to warm up for dinner. Ole'!!




