LINCOLNSHIRE HISTORY:

By: the "new - old timers"

he beginnings of a new column here in the voice, we are happy to be able to share some of the history of our community that has been buried for some time. Things that many owners know nothing about. Some things that are discussed in this column will surprise you. Over the next months we will share a little at a time – "From the beginning." Articles, interviews from the past, and research are all part of the tales we will tell.

Did you know that long before there was a Largo Florida, there was a large, beautiful lake located just a few hundred yard east of what is now Lincolnshire estates?

That entire lake was drained. Why and where did all the water go? And what is that small body of water now just south of the park behind 15th street?

An early survey (1844) shows "Lake Tolulu" in the immediate area (credit Pinellas County Museum) the lake was renamed "Lake Largo" by a surveyor in 1882 – using the Spanish name for "large" The lake was situated mostly on the property that is now East Bay Golf Club and partly on the property that is now New Haven Condominiums.

For the next few VOICE articles, we would like to present "excerpts" from the Bylaws of the LHOA. This would allow our readers to review specific <u>ARTICLES</u> "one at time". Keep in mind the entire membership are the only ones that can add, modify or

delete any parts of the Bylaws at a duly called <u>Membership Meeting</u> and must require a minimum of 25% of the Registered Members by attendance and/or proxy votes. It also requires a 30-day notice for proposed Amendments. Any member may receive a copy of the entire Bylaws by email.

ARTICLE II-PURPOSE

The purpose of the Association is to provide for the proper conduct of all business transactions of the Association and to protect the rights, privileges, integrity and security of all its members.

The Board shall, at all times, govern this Association in accordance with these by¬laws and also in accordance with the requirements of Florida Statute Chapter 723.

Lincolnshire Homeowners' Association, Inc. is not to be confused with the Lincolnshire Residents' Club, which is the organization responsible for, and limited to, the conduct of organized social activities for the residents of Lincolnshire Estates.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

- 3.1 <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>: Membership in the Association is restricted to owners of mobile homes located in Lincolnshire Estates, 1071 Donegan Road, Largo, Florida 33771 and pays Association assessments.
 - a) Membership shall not be denied to any bona fide owner of a mobile home within Lincolnshire Mobile Estates who desires membership in the Association and pays Association assessments.
 - b) Memberships may be registered jointly by husband and wife, or by an owner jointly with other individuals, but only one (1) vote may be cast per mobile home.
- 3.2 <u>MEMBERSHIP FEE:</u> The initial membership shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) payable to the Association.

The initial and <u>annual</u> membership fees for Association membership shall be determined by the Board.

(This last line gives the Board the approval to raise membership fees on an <u>annual basis</u> at their discretion or as circumstances demand. This has only been enacted once since the complete re-drafting of the Bylaws in 2015. The current annual membership fee is \$15. However, HOA Members cannot prevent the Association from paying their normal Operating Expenses.)

Military retirees and veterans receiving <u>disability pay</u> from the <u>Department of Veterans Affairs</u> are likely to see record monthly check increases for the second year running thanks to the pace of inflation, according to new estimates. The annual VA disability pay and <u>military retirement cost-of-living pay</u> adjustment, known as COLA, is typically tied to the Social Security rate change, which will likely be announced in October. An <u>early projection</u> based on national inflation data by The Senior Citizens League (TSCL), a nonpartisan senior advocacy nonprofit, estimates rates will rise by 9.6%. That increase would be the highest veterans and seniors have seen since 1981, when it went up 11.2% in response to inflation at the time, according to a TSCL press release. For 2023, that means military retirees would see an average increase of more than \$240 in their monthly retirement checks. Veterans receiving disability compensation from the VA also would see their monthly disability payments increase, with the average monthly amount going up by more than \$150.

As many of you probably know the Pact Act has finally passed. The law had called for phasing in conditions for many of the eligible veterans over the next several years. Instead, the VA will start processing claims for all beginning on Jan. 1, the "earliest possible date" the department can address them, McDonough said. "Veterans have waited too long for this care and these benefits already, and we're not going to make them wait any longer," McDonough said.

The law added 23 conditions to a list of presumptive illnesses considered related to burn pits, including certain types of cancer and respiratory illnesses, but they were to be phased in over the next three years, with those who are terminally ill, elderly or survivors having priority and eligible to file immediately.




The law also added high blood pressure to the list of illnesses presumed related to Agent Orange, a provision that could affect up to 500,000 Vietnam veterans. Most Vietnam veterans, except for those who are terminally ill; facing financial hardship or homelessness; or were 85 and older, weren't eligible to file a claim until October 2026, according to the law. However, the PACT Act gave the VA the authority to move more quickly, and McDonough said the department wants every veteran to "get the care they need and their benefits they've earned."

Traumatic and life altering brain injuries often happen from hitting hard objects like sinks, tables and concrete steps. Falling backward can result in a severe concussion too. Plus the associated hip/leg/ankle fractures leading to a very steep health decline are among causes of death in older adults who fall. Older adults fall forward. That is why so many broken hips, wrists, elbows and shoulders plus a nose or two. We no longer fall backwards as we did as toddlers. Cushy back there.

Reasons deaths with major injuries from falls have increased because we are living longer, independently, and are living with other medical issues that can effect mobility and sensation.

Some medications can make us prone to falls. That includes prescription drugs affecting balance. Certain psychiatric medications that can cause drowsiness and vision problems has increased substantially in recent years.

Falling is not 100% preventable though you can get pretty dog-gone close. If you want I certainly do. That's a great goal for all of us at Lincolnshire or at your home wherever that wonderful place is. Falls can happen anywhere! And Do! We can't fall up from the floor but the floor can cause us to fall. More on that later (a ploy to keep you reading.)

Let's face that fact that all our senses begin to age often accelerate as we get older. And the senses don't always age in the same manner or rate. Sight, Sound, and Touch are used constantly to assist in propelling all of us and our movement. When a person's ability to hear is taken away they are tentative. Simple example. You are walking on loose gravel, you feel it through a sense of touch, hear the crunch plus see it. Our pace gets adjusted to slower and bit more cautious. Gosh we are miraculous. Well I think so. Always did.

Speed is a major culprit to falls. Seems the older we get many of us want to get things done faster. Don't want to waste time. Whatever trek we make now just has to be a bit more calculated to ensure we not only get to where we are going but get back successfully. Stop the hurry!

Let's take a peek at well-known household hazards (they don't have blinking yellow lights but really should.) Number one is throw rugs on wood floors or tile. We either can slide or get caught up on them. Secondly it is electrical cords especially vacuum cleaners etc. Third is uneven floor surfaces like carpeting to wood or tile then back to carpet. Many falls in Lincolnshire are caused by the homes steps. I always use the railing no matter where. The last biggie is the bottom lip of a walk-in shower. I know this very well! Also carrying a laundry basket out the back door to the shed.

Outside our homes there are plenty of obstacles to overcome. Steps, curbs, parking space spacers, changes in the walking level and surfaces that are waiting for us. Eyes wide open here!

The last significant item is called distraction and pre-occupation. When I would ask someone who had recently fallen what was going on right before they fell. "I was talking and looking at my friend and didn't see the curb or step or my cell phone rang as I was trying to get it out of my pocket or purse." Eyes are our radar. Always keep looking forward while walking. Pay attention!

I believe you get the picture here. Even familiar surroundings have surprises.

Last attentions to our health are: get our yearly flu shot and pay attention to whether further Covid jabs are to be strongly considered. See you next month.




