





Lies and the lying liars who tell them

et's be honest — everybody lies. In fact, a survey of 2,000 U.S. adults by One Poll for Online Betting Guide found that people tell an average of four lies every day, and suspect that other people lie to them six times daily.

When do people lie? Thirty percent say they lie when asked if they like what someone else is wearing, and 27% will lie if someone makes them a meal they don't like.

Are you a convincing liar? The survey, which focused on poker, found that only about 24% of people believe they have a good poker face, while 37% think they do a good job of misleading others. Only about one in 20 people say they have a bad poker face. On the other hand, 53% of people in the survey believe they can spot when someone is lying to them, and just eight percent say they're poor at it.

On the whole, 42% of people surveyed said they feel they have a hard time concealing their true feelings, and 54% said they consider honesty very important. Assuming they're telling the truth.

### Social media distrust is widespread

I f there's one thing we can all agree on in these divided, polarized days, it's that we don't trust social media with our personal data. The Washington Post reports that although social media is ubiquitous these days, 64% of Americans feel the government should rein it in.

Among the top social media platforms, Facebook is the least trusted, with 72% expressing little or no trust in its handling of users' personal information, with 20% saying they trust it a lot. That's

followed by TikTok, which 63% of social media users don't trust, and Instagram, with 60% trust.

Amazon seems to have earned the most confidence, with 53% of customers saying they trust it a great deal or a good amount, followed by Apple at 44% and Microsoft at 43%.

Fifty-six percent of people surveyed feel that Facebook has a negative impact on society, with only 10% finding it a positive.

## Is your home safe?

our lovely home can be a death trap if you're not careful. Consumer Reports suggests checking these rooms for hidden dangers:



### <u>Kitchen</u>

- Don't fall. Close your dishwasher and oven when you're not loading or unloading them so you don't trip over the door. Wipe up spills on the floor immediately. Put items you use often on lower shelves in cabinets. If something is up high, use a sturdy stepladder, not a chair, to reach it.
- Check wiring. Have an electrician examine your kitchen wiring every few years to make sure it hasn't deteriorated to the point where it might spark a fire. Also, install GFCI outlets that will cut electric current if it fluctuates.
- Monitor your refrigerator. Protect yourself from food spoilage by making sure your refrigerator and freezer are keeping foods at the right temperature. Condensation on the walls is a sign that your unit may not be performing properly and safely.

### <u>Laundry room</u>

- Clean your dryer vent. Clogged vents can cause a fire. Clear out the lint filter before every use, and have a professional check your vents once a year. Signs that a vent is clogged include clothes taking longer to dry than usual, clothes feeling hotter to the touch just out of the dryer, and the laundry room itself feeling hot and humid, like a sauna.
- Secure detergent pods. If you use detergent pods, make sure children can't get at them. Just rubbing them on your skin or eyes can cause harm.

## Winter is coming: Prepare your home

## efore the weather gets too cold, it's wise to check your house for vulnerabilities to the coming winter. Some areas to examine:

### Roof


- Look for missing shingles, cracked flashings, and broken overhanging tree limbs.
- Check the chimney for mortar deterioration and loose bricks.
- Inspect the underside of the roof, from the attic, for any signs of leakage. <u>Exterior</u>
- Check at the foundation for cracks in the concrete, and low spots in the soil where water can accumulate against the foundation.
- Look at the caulking in the siding and around the window and door trims. *Heating system*
- Turn on the heating system to ensure that the heat is being delivered to all outlets.
- Check your filter and change it if necessary. Buy some extra filters so you can change them easily during the winter season.
