PASTA ITALIANO

- 1 lb. small shell pasta
- 1 ¹/₂ lbs. Italian sausage, mild or hot
- 1 lg. green pepper, seeded and chopped
- 1 lb. sliced mushrooms
- 3 (14 ½ oz.) cans diced tomatoes, with basil, garlic and oregano

Prepare pasta according to package directions. Sauté sausage in a large lightly oiled skillet over medium-high heat, breaking it up. For added flavor, use olive oil to sauté the sausage and vegetables. If sausage is oily, drain before adding vegetables. When sausage is almost done, add pepper and sauté for 3 minutes. Add mushrooms and cook another 2-3 minutes, or until softened. Add tomatoes and bring to a boil, reduce heat and simmer for 10 minutes. Toss mixture with pasta and serve. Makes 8 servings.

SOUTHERN POTATO SOUP

¹/₂ lb. bulk sausage
2 stalks celery
1 medium chopped onion
2 chopped carrots
2 tbs. butter
3 c. water
5 chicken or beef bullion cubes, dissolved

- 6-8 potatoes, peeled and chopped
- ³/₄ tsp. seasoned salt

Accent

½ tsp. thyme
½ tsp. Rosemary
½ tsp. garlic powder

3 c. grated longhorn cheese

2-3 c. half & half

Combine all ingredients – except cheese and milk – and cook until potatoes are tender (about 1 hr). Remove from heat and add grated longhorn cheese and half and half. Place on low heat and warm slowly, so as not to scorch milk. Serve with crackers or good crusty bread.






