



Prep time 5min. Cook time 15min. Serves 25-30

Assembly 15min.

Ingredients:

12oz. Bag Big taco chips 1 can 8oz refried beans 1 lb. Hamburger 1 pkg taco seasoning

1 - 8oz. Pkg taco cheese 1 - 8oz sour cream 1cup pico de Gallo

½ cup micro chives or 5 chopped tomatoes.



Cook hamburger and taco seasoning as directed. Heat refried beans.

Assemble in order:

chip, ½ tsp beans, 1 tsp taco mix, sprinkle cheese, ½ tsp sour cream, ½ tsp pico de Gallo, sprinkle with micro chives.

Serve warm.

SPINACH PHYLLO BUNDLES

prepared by Pat J. serves 24

Ingredients:

1 Med. Onion chopped

1 - 10oz.Pkg frozen chopped spinach thawed and squeezed dry

3 eggs - lightly beaten

3/4 tsp. Salt Pepper to taste

2 Tbs plus ½ cup butter - divided

1 cup - (4oz) feta cheeseburgers

³/₄ cup 4% cottage cheese

1/4 cup dry bread crumbs

½ tsp dill weed


20 sheets phyllo

Instructions:

In a large skillet, saute onion in 2 Tbs.Butter until tender. Remove from heat, stir in the spinach, feta, cottage cheese, eggs, bread crumbs salt, dill, and pepper.

Melt remaining butter. Layer and brush 5 phyllo sheets with melted butter. (cover remaining phyllo with damp towel and plastic to keep it from drying out). Cut sheets into 2 inch strips. Place 1 tbs filling at one end of the strip; fold into a triangle, as you would fold a flag. Place on ungreased baking sheet. Brush with butter. Repeat until phyllo is gone.

Bake at 400 for 15-20 minutes or until golden brown. Serve warm.






