<u>Air Pump</u> – Don't forget we have an air pump if your tires need air. It's located in the east parking lot, near the Adult Pool and is very simple to use. Left of the pump you will find the off/on switch; turn it on, then fill your tire. If you do not hear the motor turn on when you turn the switch on, that doesn't mean it is not functioning. If air in the tank is full, you may not hear anything until the air pressure is used and you will hear it come on as you fill your tire. Be sure to turn the switch back to the off position!

<u>Mailboxes</u> – With the holidays right around the corner, extra parcel boxes will be installed to accommodate all the packages being delivered.

<u>Rules & Regulations</u> – If you have not picked up your copy of the updated Rules & Regulations, you may stop by the office to pick one up or request one to be mailed or e-mailed to you.

New Board Members – Thinking of running for the Board? The first notice will be mailed out by November 19th which will include instructions on how to submit your intent to be a candidate. If you have accounting, organizational, management or teambuilding skills we would like to have your submission.
