

ept 28 Hurricane Ian took a turn missing Clearwater and Bayside Waters. The storm and aftermath were a close call. After the fact, it came to my attention that we had at least 75 residents who, for a number of reasons, stayed in their homes. We were so blessed our community was saved with minimal damage. With this close call, I feel it is important for our community to reestablish a Hurricane Preparedness Committee.
