
ello Sunset Palms residents,

LUSHONLY: Body waste and toilet paper. <u>It is highly recommended</u> that only one ply toilet paper be used to prevent clogging the toilet.



DON'T FLUSH: Tampons- Sanitary Pads – Diapers – Depends – Swiffer Cloths – Dust Cloths – Wet Wipes – Kleenex – Food, etc.

When we flush, the waste goes into a <u>holding tank</u> that has two pumps to expel the waste <u>UP</u> <u>and OUT</u> into the Pinellas Park sewage system. When any of the above gets flushed, it clogs the pump, overheats it, and burns out the motor.


