Then our Boca Ciega residents from Canada and from the States return in November, they will drive through the park and see that the park is the same as they left it in the spring. We are thankful that our park in Pinellas County did not have to face the unbelievable strength of Hurricane Ian that came ashore Wednesday, September 28 in Lee County. Wind was recorded at 155 mph. Storm surge was from around 12 feet to 16 feet. Water was pushed on to the land in Lee County, whereas in Tampa, the bay was emptied out again. Unbelievable.

As you know, for the longest time, Tampa was thought to be where Ian would make landfall. Our neighbors, Karen and Mark evacuated to a friend's home in St. Augustine. They drove both of their cars to that destination that turned out to be where Ian also travelled as it headed north. You just don't know. Other neighbors were invited to spend the night at a family member's home. Some neighbors did choose to stay in their own home. Most residents chose to shelter in our clubhouse.

To prepare for our residents arrival, Eric and Sheila and Aldo and Terry moved the high lounge chairs to the clubhouse. The remaining chairs were put in the pool. Umbrellas were taken down and stored and the remaining shutters were put down and secured at the clubhouse. Inside the clubhouse, Virginia made sure that necessary supplies were available like water, cups and toilet paper. The TV was turned on to Bay News 9. Residents brought up their pillows and blankets and air mattresses. They brought food from their homes and someone brought a coffee pot. I learned that dinner was made on Wednesday night and breakfast was made on

Thursday morning. A good cook is always welcomed. The gas stove in our clubhouse kitchen was put to use. The park never lost power that night. There were gusts of wind to 80 mph and rain. Some residents passed the evening playing Rummikub before they hit the sack. All went back to their homes Thursday morning and were thankful to see that the park was okay.

On the scene, after Ian's wide berth of passing by, was our super hero residents again. Eric and Sheila and Aldo and Terry, joined by Bobby. They put the park back in order. Eric and Sheila went around each street in the park and picked up any debris in our front yards. Our lawn service later picked up any debris in our backyards. As the days went by, residents started returning to the park. Earl in #44, on his hands and knees, weeded the stones around our 14 foxtail palms in the front of our park. Sounds like another super hero resident to me.

Each month of the hurricane season, I have included a Prayer for the Protection from Hurricanes. Prayer is powerful. We are praying now for the people who have lost so much in the state of Florida. Shirley has a brother in Naples and I have a brother in Fort Myers. Both of their homes had severe water damage. I had to relay a family concern to my brother, Gerry, and I guess I was getting way into the problem when Gerry said to me, "Mary, do you have floors, do you have walls, do you have lights, do you have water? Okay, you're right Gerry, everything that I was concerned about is not much at all. Thanks. I love you."

We are now looking forward to getting together and celebrating Thanksgiving at the clubhouse. Already, Ingrid is asking for help in decorating the hall. Never too early to start.

Thank you to everyone who answered all my questions as I was trying to learn about our park while I was away.





- 2 cups sugar

• 2 cups flour

- 2 tsp baking soda
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 2 tsp baking powder






