From the Board of Directors

Tello All,



By the time you read this I will have been back in Blue Jay for a couple of weeks, hopefully enjoying the warmth and sun after the cool fall up north. RI is already seeing morning temperatures in the 40's. Suzanne and I look forward to another peaceful and warm winter with friends.

I wanted to bring a couple of issues to everyone's attention after our close call with Hurricane Ian. While we may have dodged a bullet again with a last minute turn, you may have incurred some damage to your home. If you did, you may be eligible to apply for FEMA Funding to help with the repairs. I have the following information for you from FEMA. Hopefully, if you need assistance, you can get some help here.

Homeowners who need financial assistance to repair their primary residence, temporary shelter, or medical assistance should apply for FEMA Individual Disaster Assistance. FEMA asks survivors who have internet access to register for aid at DisasterAssistance.gov. If you would like to speak to a person regarding a possible claim you will be able to find phone numbers there to help. Registering will also enable FEMA to begin the process of determining eligibility for aid and services.

I also wanted to bring to your attention that scams are always popping up after instances like Ian. There are unscrupulous individuals and groups that may contact you with the offer of "assisting you in filing insurance, FEMA, or other storm related claims." Please be aware that these folks are not looking to help you but to line their own pockets with your cash. There have already been instances of elderly folks having claims registered in their names but payable to the accounts of others. Please be aware that this type of thing is going on, as well as the usual repair schemes that arise after every natural disaster. Protect yourself by being vigilant with what you sign. If you do not feel completely comfortable with the person you are dealing with, just say no. If you are not sure, talk to someone you trust.

Remember, our November meeting, which does not have a scheduled date as of this writing, is a "Members" meeting, and your presence or proxy is required to vote on budget related issues. Please plan on being there. You will receive a mailing which includes the budget immediately after the October 18th Board Meeting. This year's budget, as I have been warning, comes with a substantial hike in monthly fees due to the state of our economy. The "number" as of this writing is \$198, but could have been much worse without the hard work of our Treasurer and Property Manager. I won't list the reasons, as you see them in your own budgets at home. Our economy is in a really bad place right now. Enough said about that.

I look forward to seeing everyone and saying hello. Roland

s the holiday season begins to draw near, our local Toys for Tots

team is gearing up and is now operational. Since 1947, Marines have been making Christmas wishes come true for needy children.

This year's Toys for Tots campaign began on September 1st with the registration for families to receive toys. Last year Pinellas County distributed approx. 34,636 toys and supported over 4200 families (9,376 children).

As of November 6th, Blue Jay Estates will start collecting new/unwrapped toys via the Toys for Tots collection boxes that will be located on the stage inside the clubhouse. For monetary donations (cash/checks), we ask that these be hand delivered to us at 172 Hickory Gate Drive. Checks should be made payable to "Toys for Tots – Pinellas County".

Toys for Tots in Pinellas County makes a difference in the lives of the less fortunate children of our community. This year, they expect the need to be even greater than last and they are asking for our help. Though they accept toys for ages zero to 12, they always have additional toy needs for both girls and boys ages 10 to 12 and for children zero to 1.

The goal of Toys for Tots is that "Every Child deserves a Little Christmas," and we are asking you to help us send the needy children of our community a message of hope this Christmas, through the gift of a new toy.

For the many volunteers who make Toys for Tots possible year after year, Toys for Tots embodies the true spirit of Christmas. The gift of a shiny new toy – something that most children take for granted – means to a needy child that someone cares, that he/she hasn't been forgotten, that Christmas hasn't passed him/her by.

Volunteer openings will be announced in early November 2022. The volunteer needs will be for December 10 through December 17. FEAST Food Pantry

The FEAST Food Pantry provides food and personal care items to residents in North Pinellas County. They distribute bags of shelf stable food based on family size which typically equates to a 3–4 day supply of food. They also provide perishable food staples such as meat, milk and fresh produce to their clients which helps them to create a balanced diet for their families. Additionally, their clients receive personal care items such as toilet paper, paper towels, toothpaste and other hygiene products not permitted for purchase under SNAP.

During a visit, they ask their guests "How many in your household?" They distribute the following portions to them: 1-2 guests = 18 lbs., 3-4 guests 25 lbs., 5-6 guests 44 lbs. Weekly, FEAST is distributing approximately 4200 lbs. of food.

At any given time, the most needed items are peanut butter, jelly, pasta and sauce, canned soups, canned veggies of all kinds, side dishes like rice, mashed potatoes, pasta salad and snacks like chips, popcorn, snack bars.

FEAST will also take Aldi, Publix & Walmart gift cards as this helps them shop for any items they need most.

Donation items can be left in the blue FEAST box located within the clubhouse on the stage.

Monetary donations / gift cards should be dropped off to us personally at 172 Hickory Gate Drive.

As always, please ensure donated items are unopened and not expired.

Thank you for helping us collect for FEAST with their most crucial items listed above.
