Many of us have seen the devastation to south of us and we are thankful that our park received minimal damage. Fortunately, we were prepared with an updated hurricane manual and security team. We all owe this team our gratitude for patrolling the park and inspecting properties. The team consists of Dan Murphy (head of security), Norma Murphy, Dave Gonzales, Don Cahill, Harry and Judy Matthews, and Bernadette and Craig Drouin. Of course, our office staff; Pat, David, and Sue work endlessly preparing for the bad weather. The greatest asset and unsung hero would be Harvey Shaw who works tirelessly no matter what the situation is. Please thank these individuals when you can.

Many updates to the park are in progress or have been completed;

The pool lighting is a work in progress - the engineer is working with Duke Energy. Night swimming should be available around Thanksgiving time. The pool heater malfunctioned last month. The Reserve study has the heater's life expectancy for two more years. Unfortunately, the cost was approximately \$7,000 to replace.

There have been concerns over a trailer that is parked at lot #9. The park does indeed know it is in violation of our rules. Unfortunately, the shareholder is ill and a plenary guardian will be appointed by the courts. Once this happens the problem can be dealt with. Thank you all for your patience.

There will be changes in the park minutes, as we know them. At a recent conference, we learned from our attorney's law firm, that board minutes need to be very short and to the point. Our minutes shall now reflect the proper procedure.
