#### **New Spectrum Contract**

new Spectrum contract has been approved by the Co-op Board for the benefit of all residents and it will be implemented on December 1,

UPDATE

2022. The new features will include: every household will get one standard box and one DVR with DVR service at no cost, internet speed will increase from 300 to 500 megabytes per second, the TV channels will include the present Standard Channels plus the Tier 1 Channels (Tier 1 presently costs extra). Spectrum will supply upgraded equipment as required for every home. The improvements also include bandwidth changes which will help all those smart devices in your home and site-wide WIFI availability. The upgrades needed to improve service connectivity and speed will no longer support channel 732. In addition, Spectrum will no longer offer Tier 2 Channels.

Every home will receive a letter from Spectrum identifying those that will need equipment upgrades. Check your mail.

For the installation of any new equipment in your home to obtain all the new benefits, it will be your responsibility to obtain such equipment from Spectrum, then do the installation yourself, ask a friend or pay Spectrum for a service call. We expect this information to be included in the notification.

Your Spectrum bill may or may not change depending on your personal preferences.

We look forward to seeing all your smiling faces once again and hope you all enjoy the wonderful show.



atest Estimate Puts 'Record' Military Retiree COLA Increase in Doubt

After spending much of 2022 on a steady rise, the monthly figures used to calculate annual raises for military retirees, Social Security recipients, VA disability payees, and others have leveled



off in recent months, ending talk of a potential double-digit cost-of-living adjustment (COLA). The latest estimate by the nonpartisan Senior Citizens League puts the 2023 COLA at 8.7%, on par with the adjustment received by military retirees on March 1, 1982. It's important to note the adjustment's calculations have changed frequently over the past 40 years. The current military-retiree COLA calculation, using the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W), is also used to determine the Social Security COLA, but that wasn't always the case; Social Security recipients received a 7.4% COLA in 1982, for example, following an 11.2% boost the previous year.

Veterans Justice Outreach Specialists identify justice-involved Veterans and contact them through outreach, and they often work with Veterans treatment courts and free legal clinics. Moreover, they are frequently the point of contact for the 150+ legal clinics that serve Veterans around the country




