RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Turkey Breast Roulade with apple, corn bread and sausage

Ingredients:

- 1 TBSP. Olive oil, divided
- 1 medium fresh apple (Gala variety, peeled and finely chopped)
- 1 Rib Celery (finely chopped)
- ½ cup Onion (yellow variety, finely chopped)
- 7/8 tsp. Kosher Salt, divided
- 5 oz. Sweet Italian Sausage
- 1 TBSP. fresh Rosemary, finely chopped
- 3 ½ oz. prepared Cornbread, crumbled (about 1 cup)
- 2 TBSP Fresh Parsley, flat-leaf, finely chopped
- 2 TBSP. Maple Syrup
- 1/8 tsp. freshly ground black pepper, or to taste
- Boneless skinless turkey breast, uncooked, butterflied and flattened to ½ inch thickness

Directions:

- 1. In a large skillet with lid, heat 1 tsp. oil over medium heat.
- 2. Add apple, celery, onion and 1/8 tsp. salt.
- 3. Cook, covered, stirring once or twice, until mixture is tender, 8-10 minutes.
- 4. Add Sausage and rosemary; continue cooking (uncovered), stirring occasionally and breaking up sausage into small bits with a wooden spoon, until sausage is cooked through, 5-7 minutes more.
- 5. Remove pan from heat: stir in corn bread, parsley, maple syrup, ½ tsp. salt and generous pinch of pepper.
- 6. Transfer to a large plate to cool.
- 7. Lay turkey breast flat and season with ¼ tsp. and generous pinch of pepper.
- 8. Spread corn bread filling on top, leaving a ½ inch border. Starting at one long side, roll up turkey jelly-roll style, and secure with kitchen twine if necessary: place in a baking dish. (Roulade can be prepared 1 day ahead; cover and refrigerate.)
- 9. Preheat oven to 400 degrees with rack in the middle. Drizzle remaining 2 tsp. oil over roulade; roast until thermometer inserted into thickest part registers 165 degrees, 40-45 minute.
- 10. Remove roulade from oven; transfer to a cutting board and let rest at least 15 minutes. Slice crosswise into 8 thick or 16 thin pieces, serve.
- 11. This is a great substitute instead of stuffing and cooking a whole turkey for only 1-4 people.

- 12. As a side dish, make Fresh Cranberry-apple Relish.
- 13. 12-ounce Fresh Cranberries,(frozen also works, no need to thaw); 1 large fresh apple (peeled, cored and cut in chunks) 2/3 cup sugar, ½ tsp. lemon zest and ¼ tsp. table salt.
- 14. Put cranberries and apple in a food processor; pulse until finely chopped and spoon into a medium bowl.
- 15. Add sugar, lemon zest, and salt to bowl. Stir, cover and refrigerate at least 30 minutes for flavors to blend.

Serving size: 1 ½ rounded tablespoons

May be stored in the refrigerator for several days, iust add a dash of lemon juice before storing to prevent apples from



FROM THE OFFICE

The Office



nce again, we missed a "sure thing" as Hurricane Ian spared the Tampa Bay area. I estimated that about 60% of the residents heeded the mandatory evacuation order; unfortunately, some of them ended up in the path of high water that followed after the Hurricane devastated towns to the south of us. Even though mobile home parks are considered "mandatory evacuation" zones, not everyone has the resources it takes to leave, and shelters are a poor option. I just wish I could make you understand how important it is that the Office knows who is leaving (or staying)! If we ever get a major storm, residents may die because no one knows they are here, or time is wasted searching mobiles where the residents have left. Hurricane season runs through the end of November.

Important information for when we have an extended power outage or storm in our area: you should limit the use of water and flushing toilets when power is out, and for a few days after it comes back on. It takes power to run Embassy's lift stations, and we are just a small part of Pinellas County, so we do not know if the county systems are up and running and able to accept sewage from our lift stations. You should wait a few days to do laundry after a power outage as this adds extra water to dispose of.

Speaking of laundry, we did lose more of the fence at the 12th street laundry; I am in the process of getting the entire fence replaced, whether wood or vinyl will depend on the price and availability.

The monthly calendar in the center of this issue may not be 100% correct, I had to use the information from last spring's planning meeting as none of the park committees have confirmed any details for this year. The calendar will be posted in a display case outside of the Clubhouse back door (by the pool). I have ordered new display cases for flyers, one for the front of the clubhouse and one for the back (besides the one for the calendar). They will have locks on them, which will be available in the Clubhouse. The locks on the Clubhouse have been changed; if you qualify to have a key you will need to stop in the office, verify why you need a key, sign for it, and return it at the end of the season. When too many residents have keys, it is hard to hold anyone accountable when the lights and a/c are left on, or the doors are not properly locked. The bathrooms by the pool are not only for the pool users but also the shufflers until the Clubhouse is opened for their break. There will also be a key available for any resident who needs it for a one-time event. Hobby House keys remain the same, no one should have one except the Sewing Club and Bible Study.

Hopefully by the time you are reading this the pool deck will be refinished; as of today I am waiting on the company to get us on their schedule. If it's not done yet, it will be closed for about a week when it is. We have had to wait for dryer weather and cooler temperatures to do it. Dennis Larocque is here for a week, Dennis, Roy, Patrick & Brandon fixed all of the broken straps on the pool furniture.

mold on the exterior and shutters of your mobile and messy backyards. Just a reminder, Park rules state that all mobiles must be power washed a minimum of once a year. There are several power washing companies that advertise in the News and Views; I use one of them, it is less than \$100 and he does an awesome job. Many back yards can't be mowed because the trees have become over grown and the mower can't get through. You are responsible for all trees and shrubs on your lot except the palm tree in the front of your mobile (if there still is one, many have died and been removed).

It is very hard for me to know when a resident moves in extra people, or underage people. I rely on help from the neighborhood watch and other residents who see new people coming and going. I will gladly verify with you if I am aware of any extra people if you bring it to my attention....I do not reveal my source when I confront them! Residents need to understand that you cannot move your adult children into your home just because they have no other place to go, or they have been arrested and need an address in order to be released! We are a 55+ park and I do not participate in what is called the 80/20 rule. The resident must have a doctor's letter stating they need 24/7 care, and the caregiver must be a certified caregiver in the state of Florida. I will sometimes make an exception for a short period of time while they find a place to go, depending on the circumstances. Anyone staying over 30 days needs a background check. I have people telling me they own the mobile so they can have anyone they want live there.... WRONG! Read the rules that you signed for, it is all spelled out in there.

Also, I would appreciate any articles from residents to enhance the News & Views...like what it was like preparing for a hurricane, especially the Canadians who had one in Canada and one here the next week, where you went on vacation, etc. (Still need recipes). Jessie Buchholtz, Property Manager






