We need to make sure we have you noted as "IN" to make sure we any mailings are sent to you here and we can give you the newest dial directory. Also, if you have an updated driver's license, please stop by the office so we can make a copy for your file.

RANCHERO VILLAGE - GARBAGE & RECYCLING:

******ALL TRASH AND RECYCLING WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF IT IS MORE THAN 1 FOOT FROM THE ROAD. *******

- 1. Kitchen and household waste:
 - a. Garbage should be placed in plastic bags not to exceed 25lbs, tied, and placed at the street for pick up by 8:00 a.m. Monday and Friday. If a holiday should fall on any pick-up day, that pick up will be lost and not made up.
 - b. NO garbage or recycling should not be placed on the street overnight.
- 2. Trimming/yard waste and construction debris:
 - a. This waste will be collected Monday and Friday after 8:00 a.m. MUST be bundled or bagged and less than 25 lbs. and not over 3 feet in length.
 - b. Two "roll off" dumpsters are available in the maintenance yard at the west end of 3rd St. for residence use only. Contractors doing work in the community should not use the community dumpster.
- 3. Recycling:
 - a. Wednesday is recycling collection, place containers at the street by 8:00a.m.
 - b. "NO PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY SORT". Container can be all "mixed recycling", including mixed paper, flattened carboard, aluminum foil trays, tin or steel food cans, glass bottles and jars, milk and juice paper cartons and all plastic #1-7 (on the bottom of the container), these include butter tubs, fruit containers, take out plates, plastic cups, yogurt containers, plastic clam shell containers, etc... any plastic with a recycling sign. PLEASE ... NO PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY SORT! ALL CARDBOARD BOXES MUST BE BROKE DOWN.
 - c. Expansion to the recycling program will be implemented as approved by the City of Largo.

(All Misc. items must be in approved flowerbeds.) f. Solar garden lights (All Solar garden lights must be in approved flowerbeds.) g. Flowerpots (All Flowerpots must be in approved flowerbeds) h. Wet grass i. Carpets/Rugs (should not extend to the end of carports or paver areas) Weed whacking a. All homes with vinyl siding to the ground must have a 6" buffer around homes; Homeowner will be responsible for maintaining the 6-inch buffer. b. Management or Lawn Maintenance will not be responsible for any damages. Blowing – Most carports, all sidewalks will be blown into the street. The following will not be blown: a. Carport if full of Misc. items b. Back patio Edging – as needed a. To 1 st post of the carports b. Along streets c. Sidewalks General information: a. Recycling bins should be placed on driveway or sidewalk, not on grass. b. Management and lawn maintenance are not responsible for trees and bushes in grass area. c. No mow signs should only be placed out on Wednesdays and removed Wednesday night. d. Less obstacles makes it more efficient for lawn maintenance. e. If you wish, vehicles can be parked at the clubhouses during grass cutting hours. f. No parking along the street so the sweeper can access these areas. Thank you for your continued cooperation.

No mow signs should only be placed out on Wednesdays and removed Wednesday night. d. Less obstacles makes it more efficient for lawn maintenance. e. If you wish, vehicles can be parked at the clubhouses during grass cutting hours. f. No parking along the street so the sweeper can access these areas. Thank you for your continued cooperation.

SEASONAL REMINDERS

Fall is here and it's time to check the batteries in your smoke alarms.

It is also the time to put the Root Kill down the sewer to keep roots from plugging up your plumbing. Cooper Sulfate, available at local hardware stores, should be used twice a year: once in spring and again in the fall.

DOG WALKING

All dog walkers be sure to walk your pet only in the dog section and only on the side of the street designated as dog section. Many streets are designated "dog section" on one side of the street, but the other side is not in the dog section. Keep your neighbors happy and obey the pet rules. And, of course, don't forget the 'Litter" bag. If you have a service dog in the non-dog section, please be respectful and use your lawn only.

DOOR TO DOOR SALES Call the Largo Police Department (727-587-6730) immediately and please notify the community office if you have a solicitor come to your door. Even if you think you can just send them away with no harm, please remember they will be preying on your neighbors. Be a good neighbor and help to get rid of these predators. If a solicitor tells you they have received permission from the office to be in the park, do not believe it. Management **NEVER** gives permission for solicitation. DO NOT allow any strangers in your home.

POOL RULES

All the rules for the pool apply to all people at all times. The Corral Pool has extended hours, from 6:00am – 11:00pm. The children's hours are now 10:00am -11:00pm. The rules posted as well as those which we highlight in this Bulletin are to be followed at all hours and conditions. Just because no one else is at the pool when you are, does not mean the rules can be altered for your convenience. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed, and tragedy can strike quickly. <u>Never</u> swim alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores.

GLASS BOTTLES – PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.

<u>No smoking at the pools</u> – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas. This includes vapor and e-cigarettes.


