

THE WONDERFUL WORLD OF DISNEY

after visiting Griffith Park in Los Angeles with his daughters. The concept was simple: build a destination where adults and their children could go to bond and have fun together. Although he was busy with his film company Walt Disney Studios at the time, Walt realized that a movie studio didn't offer much to visiting fans and began to conceptualize an amusement park near the Burbank studios for guests



to visit. The concept was to be named Mickey Mouse Park, and span 8-acres across Riverside Drive. Construction of Disneyland began on July 16, 1954, and was opened one year and one day later (July 17, 1955) to much fanfare. It cost \$17 million to complete the project. Soon Walt Disney began to think of expanding beyond California. Only 5% of Disneyland's visitors came from east of the Mississippi (where 75% of the USA population lived) so it made sense to look eastward. In 1963, Walt Disney flew over a landmass in Orlando, Florida which appeared to have a network of well-developed roads. He chose a site near Bay Lake to begin the construction of his new theme park. Soon the Walt Disney World Company would begin to acquire 30,500 acres (48 sq mi) of land by using various dummy corporations to avoid land speculation claims. After amassing land in secrecy, the plan – known as "The Florida Project" – was revealed to the public in late 1965. The new theme park was heralded by Florida's governor Haydon Burns as "the greatest attraction in the history of Florida." Walt Disney's original vision included

a planned-community concept — called "Experimental Prototype of Community Tomorrow" (EPCOT) to serve as a testing ground for new urban innovations. Walt Disney fell ill and died of circulatory collapse (lung cancer) on December 15, 1966, as the construction of the project was underway. Unfortunately, he would not live to witness the opening of Walt Disney World Resort. Without Walt overseeing the construction, the Walt Disney Company abandoned the experimental concept of a planned community in favor of building a resort that closely resembled Disneyland. This early construction led to the 1971 opening of Magic Kingdom Disney World's first theme park. After Walt's death, his brother and business partner Roy O. Disney was now in charge of overseeing the first phase of construction. During this time, the first roads were laid and then Magic Kingdom theme park, the Contemporary Resort, and Polynesian Village were completed. Two golf courses - Palm and Magnolia - were also built next to Magic Kingdom and opened in Sept. 1971. Magic Kingdom was soon to follow, officially opening to the general public on October 1, 1971. Fort Wilderness opened just one month later. At the dedication ceremony, Roy O. Disney announced that the resort would be known as "Walt Disney World" in honor of his brother. Roy wanted Walt's name to be recognizable as the man who started it all in much the same way that Henry Ford's name and legacy are synonymous with Ford automobiles. In 1971, admission prices to Magic Kingdom were \$3.50 for adults, \$2.50 for kids under 18, and one dollar for children under twelve years of age. After Walt Disney's death, his plans for an experimental planned community were abandoned by the company because they determined that running a city would be too complex of a task. However, the general concept behind the project was designed into Disney World's second theme park, EPCOT Center. EPCOT Center opened in 1982 (renamed to just EPCOT in 1996) and incorporated several of Walt's ideas including the promotion of modern innovation through edutainment attractions (Future World) and showcasing a world nation's exposition (the 11 countries of World Showcase). Some of the urban planning concepts from Walt's original EPCOT plan would later be integrated into the planned community of Celebration Florida. Hollywood Studios Disney-MGM Studios opened in 1989 as Disney World's third theme park. The park was initially developed to include both a theme park inspired by show business (film, television, music) and a fully operating production studio for film, television, and animation production services w/a backlot. The theme park was re-named Disney's Hollywood Studios in 2008 and began to phase out the "studio-like" attractions in order to focus on the attraction development and immersive theming of Hollywood-inspired stories. Animal Kingdom Disney's 4th theme park, Animal Kingdom, opened on Earth Day, April 22, 1998. The park is dedicated to animal conservation and the natural environment, a cause Walt Disney himself was passionate about. Disney's Animal Kingdom is unique in that the theme park features traditional attractions while also showcasing hundreds of species of live animals. The park is accredited by the World Association of Zoos and Aquariums which certifies they meet the standards in research, education, and conservation. Typhoon Lagoon opened in 1989 as Disney World's first water park. It boasts one of the world's largest outdoor wave pools. Blizzard Beach is the sister water park to Typhoon Lagoon and opened in 2016.


2 pounds lean ground beef



DAY TRIPPIN' ~ Honey Moon Island State Park

short drive from Tampa, beautiful Honeymoon Island offers visitors an escape from the bustle of city life. One of Florida's best-loved state parks, Honeymoon Island has more than four miles of beach to explore along with a three-mile trail through one of the last remaining virgin slash pine forests. When looking skyward, eagles, osprey and great horned owls can be seen, while ground animals include gopher tortoises, raccoons and armadillos. A trip to the Rotary Centennial Nature Center helps visitors learn about the park's history and natural resources. Find out how Honeymoon Island received its name!




Swimming, fishing, shelling, hiking and bicycling are all popular activities that make Honeymoon Island State Park an ideal getaway. Surf and pass fishing can yield catches of flounder, snook, trout, redfish, snapper, whiting, sheepshead, pompano, Spanish mackerel, cobia, ladyfish and tarpon. All fishing within the park must conform to regulations concerning size, number, method of capture and season. A fishing license may be required. Kayaks can be rented through the concession or, if you have your own, explore Pelican Cove, which lies between the sand spit and nature trail. A picnic area is located on the northern end of the island. There are picnic tables, two covered pavilions, restrooms and barbecue grills. Surfing is allowed in the park, and it's usually pretty good on the north end by bathhouse 3. With approximately four miles of shoreline, beach lovers will find a variety of activities with areas designated for swimming on the main beach, a pet beach on the south end, and great shelling and walking on the north end, which turns into a sand spit. Showers are located near the boardwalks leading out to the main beach areas. The park is open 8 a.m. until sundown, 365 days a year. \$8 per vehicle (limit eight people). \$4 single-occupant vehicle. \$2 pedestrians, bicyclists, extra passengers, and passengers in a vehicle with holder of Annual Individual Entrance Pass. \$4 per vehicle: Sunset fee, starting one hour prior to park closing

NEW TECHNOLOGY FOR SAVING ENDANGERED SEA TURTLES

Researchers have found that by placing decoy eggs into nests on the beach, it could be possible to gather key evidence needed to stop the illegal trade of baby sea turtles. This is the finding of a new study published in the journal *Current Biology* that explains how the researchers specifically tested how well the decoy eggs work and their safety for the turtles. "Our research showed that placing a decoy into a turtle nest did not damage the incubating embryos and that the decoys work," says lead author Helen Pheasey of the University of Kent.

"We showed that it was possible to track illegally removed eggs from beach to end consumer as shown by our longest track, which identified the entire trade chain covering 137 kilometers." The GPS-enabled egg decoys, dubbed InvestEggator, were developed by the conservation organization Paso Pacifico to address the illegal trade of turtles in Central America, where they are smuggled from beaches and sold to restaurants and bars as a delicacy. Paso Pacifico-affiliated scientist Kim Williams-Guillen conceived and designed the decoys in response to a call for proposals from the



United States Agency for International Development (USAID) Wildlife Crime Tech Challenge. They were looking for projects using technological advances to fight wildlife poaching. "The idea was kind of an 'Aha' moment," Williams-Guillen says. It immediately brought to mind two of her favorite TV shows, "Breaking Bad" and "The Wire," which both happened to deal with illegal drug trafficking. "In 'Breaking Bad', the DEA places a GPS tracking device on a tank of chemicals to see who receives the chemicals," she said. "In one episode of 'The Wire', two police officers plant an audio device in a tennis ball to surreptitiously record a suspected drug dealer. "Turtle eggs basically look like ping pong balls, and we wanted to know where they were going." Put those two ideas together and you have the InvestEGGator. To see how well they'd work in practice, Pheasey and her colleagues put the 3D-printed decoys in 101 turtle nests on four beaches in Costa Rica. A quarter of the fake eggs were taken illegally from the nests, allowing the researchers to track eggs from five clutches, including two green turtle nests and three olive ridley nests. One of the decoys made it close to a residential property before going silent. Another went two kilometers to a bar. The one that went farthest ended up 137 kilometers inland, spending two days in transit from the beach to a supermarket loading-bay and then on to a residential property. The researchers assume the egg wasn't sold at the market but was rather handed off, from a trafficker to a salesperson. They also got some anecdotal reports of cases where someone discovered the decoy. "One decoy went off-line in a residential area near Cariari, a town 43 km from the deployment beach," they wrote. "After 11 days, we received photographs, sent from Cariari, of the dissected egg." Along with the photos, they got information about where the egg was purchased and how many eggs had been exchanged, yielding intelligence information in addition to tracking data. Pheasey says that the early evidence shows that the majority of stolen eggs don't leave the local area. The finding reaffirmed their suspicions, as well as some local reports that most of the trade takes place close to the nesting beach. "Knowing that a high proportion of eggs remain in the local area helps us target our conservation efforts," Pheasey says. "We can now focus our efforts on raising awareness in the local communities and direct law enforcement to this local issue. It also means we know where the consumers are, which assists us in focusing demand reduction campaigns." Pheasey says that the key thing isn't to find the people who take the eggs from the beach. who are trafficking and selling the eggs, often door to door. "As trafficking is a more serious crime, those handover points are far more valuable from a law enforcement perspective than catching someone taking a nest," Pheasey says. That's what makes the InvestEGGator such an important tool, according to Williams-Guillen. "But," she adds, "it really must be used in the context of a multi-pronged conservation approach that uses education, building better economic opportunities, and enforcement to help fight sea turtle egg poaching." In addition to continuing to improve the technology and its deployment, they're also interested in expanding the technology to other species. For example, Paso Pacifico plans to work with Costa Rican scientists to adapt the transmitter for use in tracking shipments of shark fins, and possibly the theft of eggs from parrot nests.




